

5. DiSCA/DHORC 3-hours of Sebring – Sat 18Feb23

DiSCA and DHORC are pleased to announce the second Oxigen 3 hours of Sebring on Saturday 18th February 2023, in the Derby Leisure & Event Venue (DL&EV) Table Tennis Room, Derby, UK.



Event information

After one season of successful 1:32 digital racing for DHORC, further investment has been made giving the club the capability to host Oxigen racing. Whereas the previous DiSCA-partnered event used Ninco track, the 2023 event will take place on a two lane Carrera-Oxigen layout.

There will be a morning practice session, two qualifying races, and the main three hour race in the afternoon. Teams may be made of two or three drivers.

Qualifying Races will be composed of a 5 minute qualifying session to determine the grid, and then a 20 minute sprint race. The aggregate lap score from both 20 minutes races will determine the grid and rostrum priority for the main 3 hour race. No one driver may take part in both qualifying races - it's one race for each driver. For three man teams one person will have to sit out and hone their marshalling skills.. or tea making 😇

GT4 Cars

Any GT car by Scalextric or Carrera, built to GT4 Pro regulations and with the exception of the Ford GT, will be allowed to race. As previously we will also allow Touring Cars in this race, but there will be no formal category for them.

Since the last event, the GT4 Pro regulations have changed. Where previously 3D printed chassis were allowed with the intention of converting sidewinder models to inline, this is no longer permitted. All chassis must be original equipment with upgraded axels, gears and wheels permitted. Full regs are attached and can also be found on officialdisca.com

Teams must supply their own motor; PSR-AC6 20k double shaft. Motor modifications are strictly illegal. The manufacturing code must be clearly visible on the can.

Rear tyres will be hand-out Slotit 1028 P6, teams will be provided one set for the event. Tyre wear on the Carrera surface is expected to be negligible. You will need to have compatible wheels fitted to your car.

The Oxigen wireless digital system will require teams to fit a Type C or B2 oxigen in car chip to their cars and use a Slotit SCP1/2/3 hand controller.

Traction magnets are not allowed!


6. Introduction of 5-minute Sprint Races




As discussed via WhatsApp and E-mail we have all agreed to trial four 5-minute Sprint Races in 2023, two on the Indy Circuit at Brands Hatch and two at the Outer Circuit at Sakhir. Both at the second Evening on these two circuits on 01Aug23 and 10Oct23 respectively.

The way the evenings will be run is that we will have two normal 15-minute races for all Groups on the full tracks and then switch to the shorter circuit and run two 5-minute Sprint Races. There will be no pit stops, just a straight race to the flag. To save time each Group will run their races consecutively starting with either Group E or Group D, depending on how many competitors there are on the night.

Half points will be awarded for both races and the combined scores used towards the Championship. The individual scores can't be used as a worse score towards the end of the year only the combined scores on the night. We will review the success of these Sprint Races at this year's AGM.






7. Paul Ricard's Test Night – 14th February 2023

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



Angus starts 2023 as he finished 2022

Angus Smith, our first Carrera Digital Champion, started 2023 as he finished 2022 with victory, his record 17th, as well as his record 28th fastest lap. From 16th on the grid, as he crashed during the Crash & Burn Qualifying, he beat fellow Qualifying crasher **Simon Goodlip** by 0.8 laps to set the initial laps record at Imola. His fastest lap was taken by mistakenly driving through the pits! If it is good enough for Ayton Senna at Donington Park it is good enough for Angus! Ten times race winner **Dean Garbett** completed the Podium with the first three finishing in the same order as their Ranking.

Geoff Peach was on it on Tuesday night as he made it four Group A racers in the top four, just 0.3 laps off the podium places. Phil Rees took the first maximum 11 Group points by winning the B from sixth on the Group's grid. He beat the fifth Group A racer **Steve White** by a good 2.8 laps who was just 0.1 laps ahead of friend Martin Thorpe. This was also Steve's very first, of many I am sure, Poles. Another 1.3 laps further back was the last of the Group A racers **Nick Sismey**.

John Yates set the sixth (a PB by one place) fastest lap of the Round as he took ninth from third overall on the grid (his previous best being sixth), winning Group C by 1.4 laps from **Tom Gray**. As Tom moved up from C5 to C2 he actually took home more points than winner John, 8 to 6. I do like Angus' new Group point system as it awards movements up the Group grid.

Having won the first HO race of the year the previous Tuesday Lee Pateman took 11th here just 0.1 laps behind Tom. Tom's dad Stuart Gray took the second most Group points of the Round, 9, by winning the D from D4 on the grid. He pipped Dave Edwards by the smallest of margins, 0.1 laps. Exactly a lap further back was Lewis Blacker and Jono Johnson who shared 14th in the final standings. With so many on the grid we were only halfway by now! Both set Qualifying PBs with Lewis improving from 11th to 9th and Lewis 5th to 4th!

Jag Kalyan is clearly getting into his stride this year, taking 16th overall, 0.4 laps back while **Richard Booth** had improved his best Qualifying position from 11th to 7th before finishing 17th a lap behind Jag. Jag also set the 12th fastest lap, two better than his previous attempts.


Laura Edwards outscored fellow Group D racer **Liam Smith** by a common amount in Round 1, 0.1 laps. This was the fourth time this gap happened as well as the one draw in the top 19 places. **Daniel Kalyan** couldn't match his dad this time as he took 20th out on his own. He was 2.6 laps behind Liam and 2.3 ahead of Macaully Dutson.

JJ Hughes-Dowd was the first racer to ever win Group E as this was the first time we had ever run Group E as we had 27 racers on the night (although 26 in Round 1). Due to the time constraints we had to run all three of E's 15-minute races between 17:00 and 18:00 hours. Luckily we just about had enough marshals to manage it. While this weeks was an all Hughes-Dowd affair, future Es will be run with different racers. JJ was 1.1 laps behind Macaully but 0.2 laps ahead of future Group E racer **John Lamb**.

From 13th on the grid (his previous best being 21st) **JT Hughes-Dowd** was next up, with a 0.1 lap gap again raising its head as **Simon Rankin** was that distance behind JT. **Dan Hughes-Dowd's** car hit the deck at the last chicane (an additional barrier was subsequently added) causing his 935's rear axle to lock. Angus managed to sort it for him, but the time lost left him in 26th and last. He had however set the 16th best Qualifying lap for this Round, his previous best being 19th so all was not lost!

Simon gets into his stride!

Simon Goodlip added 0.4 laps here to **Angus Smith's** race laps record, set in Round 1, to beat the latter by 2.4 laps. He didn't only beat Angus by 2.4 laps but **Dean Garbett** as well as both stood on the second step of the podium. Dean actually beat Angus on the road but as we can't differentiate between the same laps and tenths between Groups (we don't know where within each tenth each car finishes) we can't differentiate within Groups. Dean also set his very first fastest lap, which is a surprise considering he has ten wins under his belt! It was the only PB anyone would set in this Round! Even more incredibly Angus only set the 8th fastest lap in the Round!

Geoff Peach was again knocking on the door of the podium with fourth place for the second Round in a row. Slower approach to pit stops may well have seen him on the podium! Martin Thorpe would be one of two racers to record 10 Group points this Round as he won Group B ahead of Group B rival Phil Rees, 0.7 laps the gap. The meat in their sandwich was Nick Sismey, fifth in the A and sixth overall, 0.2 laps down on Martin.







Tom Gray was certainly in good form on the Imola circuit. After taking 10th in Round 1 he moved up to 8th here, beating three time winner and Group A racer **Steve White** by 0.8 laps. He therefore joined Martin on 10 Group points. Tom's uncle **Richard Booth** recorded his best result of the night rounding out the top ten.

Lewis Blacker just missed the top ten with 11th, 0.3 laps back, also recording the 11th fastest lap. Having refuelled after work Chris Cooper made it 27 starters in Round 2. His first competitive race saw him finish 0.3 laps behind Lewis, but 0.4 laps ahead of the previous Round's Group C winner John Yates who too 13th overall and 3rd in the Group.

Jag Kalyan went two better in this Round with 14th while John Lamb catapulted up eight places from 23rd to 15th. Dave Edwards added three Group points for taking 4th in the C and 16th overall, while Jono Johnson added five Group points with second in the D. Lee Pateman dropped seven places this round with 18th overall, Imola not suiting his style of racing, unlike a week earlier where he dominated the Miami HO track.

Stuart Gray also didn't find Round 2 as good as Round 1 with 19th this time with Laura Edwards bringing home her DHORC liveried BMW in 20th. There were still seven racers behind her! Liam Smith was the first of this seven 2.8 laps back while JT Hughes-Dowd became our latest Group winner as his DTM BMW won Group E. He was exactly half a lap ahead of brother JJ Hughes-Dowd who was running his new motor in.

Daniel Kalyan took 24th this time but did improve on his fastest lap by over two tenths. **Dan Hughes-Dowd** moved off the bottom of the table with 25th this time, with Macaully Dutson 1.4 laps back in 26th. Simon Rankin became our first racer to take a 27th and final points scoring place after his Aston Martin suffered a rear wheel failure (See Page 41) following a coming together with the barrier at the Tosa Hairpin, at a high rate of knots! He would change rear axle for Round 3.

Simon takes back to back victories

Simon Goodlip followed his second career victory immediately with his third, adding 0.2 laps to his 15-minutes lap's record leaving it at 83.4. This took Simon to the top of the Championship table ahead of early 2022 Championship leader **Dean Garbett** by 17 points, as Dean again took second, beating Simon's previous laps record. Just 0.1 laps more and we would have had our first double winner!

Martin Thorpe matched his best ever finish of third, at Round 15 in 2022, here after another incredible battle with Phil Rees in Group B. Martin became just the sixth racer, which included Phil at the previous Round, to record 80+ laps at Imola. He must be looking for a top two in the future with Phil already on two wins. Phil leads the Group Championship by one point from Martin while **Angus Smith's** fifth here leaves him one point behind Dean in the main Championship in third. He did take a record 26th Pole though.

Steve White equalled his Round 1 result here with sixth again after dropping to ninth in the previous Round. He was 0.1 laps behind Angus while **Lewis Blacker** got it together moving up from 14th in Round 1, 11th in Round 2 to seventh here. **Geoff Peach** was very vocal in the final Round of the night; I know as I was stood next to him! He turned this into his first career fastest lap, becoming only the fourth racer to dip below the nine second bracket. His next target is to convert this passion into his first win, as while he was the fastest in Round 3 he dropped from fourth in Rounds 1 and 2 to eighth here, 0.5 laps down on Lewis!





Dave Edwards was mid pack with a 13th, 15th and 16th while Chris Cooper was the only driver to miss Round 1 took 12th and 14th in the remaining Rounds.

Jag Kalyan drove out of his skin to record his best ever finish here, ninth, three better than his previous best finish, beating Group A racer **Nick Sismey** by 1.6 laps! He also beat Group C winner (for the second time of the Evening) **John Yates** by the same margin as John equalled Nick in 10th. Jag also set the 8th fastest lap, four places better than his previous best of 12th.

Just half a lap back were **Tom Gray** and **Richard Booth** sharing 12th overall. Tom's eight Group points leaves him in third in the Group Championship, two points behind Martin while Richard is another three points further back. **Stuart Gray** makes it a three way family affair in the Group Challenge as his 16th overall and second in Group D gave him seven Group points resulting in a total of 21 points in fifth. Richard also set the sixth fastest lap in Round 3 an incredible five places better than his previous best of 11th set a year ago!

Macaully Dutson separated these two from dad **Dan Hughes-Dowd** who rounded out the field this time. Submerging Dan amongst Group D racers next time is bound to push him up the table.





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3.0 Driving & Racing Standards (Based on The Digital Slot Car Association Rules)

3.1. Any car on the circuit must be compliant with the GT rules.

3.2. Any indiscretion against stated regulations will be punishable by penalty (to be agreed).

3.3. When lapping a slower car, it is the responsibility of the faster car to change lanes and perform an overtake. Lapped cars should remain in their current lane until the faster car has passed.

3.3.1. Intentionally blocking of a faster car when lapping is illegal

3.3.2. Intentionally blocking a car fighting for position on the same lap is allowed

3.4. Contact from cars racing on the same lane, in proximity, is to be expected. Intentional or excessive contact is not allowed. Penalties (to be agreed) will be issued in the following circumstances: -

3.4.1. Intentional or excessive contact with another car

3.4.2. De-slotting another car by driving into the back of it

3.4.3. Intentionally stopping on the circuit

3.4.4. Excessive blocking by changing lanes when being lapped

3.5. Illegal contact may be reported by any participant of the meeting

3.6. Cars may be requested to pit for attention under the following circumstances: -

3.6.1. Any functional or mechanical part of the car has become completely detached from the car

3.6.2. A wing or spoiler becomes broken, completely detached from the body, or it is clear to the official at race control that when viewing the car from their normal position, that it is damaged

3.6.3. The required number of headlights/taillights are not working

3.6.4. A car is otherwise causing a hazard that may damage the circuit or other cars on the circuit

3.7. If any session is paused (red flagged), the following restrictions apply: -

3.7.1. Cars must not be removed from the track, where they have come to stop

3.7.2. Any car in the pit at the time of the red flag must have no further work completed on it until the session is resumed

3.7.3. Drivers may leave their station only under the direction of race control

3.8. During Parc Ferme conditions, cars may only be worked on under the supervision of an official

3.9. Slow or malfunctioning cars should move to the inside lane (or lane nearest to the pit) and pit as soon as possible. Race control should be notified that there is a slow car on circuit so other drivers may be warned

Circuit History

The **Autodromo Internazionale Enzo e Dino Ferrari**, better known as **Imola**, is a 4.909 km (3.050 mi) motor racing circuit in the town of Imola, in the Emilia-Romagna region of Italy, 40 km (25 mi) east of Bologna. It is one of the few major international circuits to run in an anti-clockwise direction. The circuit is named after Ferrari's late founder, Enzo Ferrari (1898–1988), and his son, Alfredo "Dino" Ferrari (1932–1956). Before Enzo's death, it was called Autodromo Dino Ferrari. The circuit has an FIA Grade One licence.

Imola was the venue for the San Marino Grand Prix between 1981 and 2006. During this period, two Grands Prix were held in Italy every year, with the Italian Grand Prix taking place at Monza, so the Imola race was named after the nearby state. Imola also hosted the 1980 Italian Grand Prix in place of Monza. When Formula One visits Imola, it is seen as the home circuit of Scuderia Ferrari, and masses of supporters come out to support the local team.

The venue returned to the Formula One calendar during the 2020 season to help the sport fill calendar gaps caused by cancellations of other races due to the COVID-19 pandemic, with the race at the circuit being named the Emilia Romagna Grand Prix in honour of the region where the circuit is located. This also meant the venue hosted a World Championship race under a third different name having hosted the 1980 Italian Grand Prix and the San Marino Grand Prix from 1981 to 2006. In March 2022 Liberty Media signed a contract with the circuit to make it a permanent entry on the main calendar until at least 2025.
