


2. Congrats to the king of Sebring, Dean Garbett

Dean Garbett was virtually untouchable at Sebring, taking seven wins from nine starts, giving him a commanding lead in the DHORC-CD Championship. Only **Phil Rees** and **Nick Sismey** took the other race wins.

Despite all these wins he only set two Pole Positions. One during the initial qualifying session and the second when John Lamb had set Pole at the end of Evening 1 but was unable to attend the Evening 2 races, giving Pole to Dean. Dean has also not set any Fastest Laps in any of the nine Club Nights to date, showing that the way to win is consistency and not top speed. This is exactly what Martin Chadwick used to do in HO hence his number of wins but very few Fastest Laps.

Will Dean's domination continue at the faster Sakhir circuit from 12Apr22?





6. John Yates testing in Phil Rees' man cave


Before his first DHORC evening on Tuesday night **John Yates** visited Phil Rees' man cave, last Friday, to have some practice and his car set up.






7. Changes to SmartRace app to speed up racing

To speed up the time between races we have agreed to not add folks' names and car to the App each time. We will just have Driver 1, Driver 2 and Car 1, Car 2 etc. That means, once the cars have been configured to a particular hand controller position at the beginning of the evening there is no more work for Race Control to do between races. As soon as one Group's race results have been recorded on the Excel spreadsheet the next Group can plug their hand controllers in and their cars placed on the track and the next race can start. This will mean more racing and less faffing.



8. Sakhir Test, including Qualifying 29Mar22


After almost a year of testing and racing on the superb Sebring circuit we finally change track to the F1 Sakhir circuit next Tuesday for our first Bahrain Test Night. We will be running 5-minute races so that everyone can get in as many races as possible with as many cars as they want. Also, to save time at the first Sakhir Club Night on 12Apr22 we will Qualify at the end of the Test Night. Hopefully as many of you as possible can attend the Test Night to reduce the amount of Qualifying we need to do on 12Apr22.

The first is the British Touring Car Championship weekend on 23/24Apr22 where we will construct our gazebos in the Paddock just outside the Donington Park Megastore. Luckily, Donington Park allow us to keep our gazebos in their storeroom, just behind where we put them up, saving us transporting them to each event.

We usually have up to six volunteers supporting the track each day so if you are available, please let me know. With only five needed to run our circuit at any one time it means someone can always be checking the real on track action or walking around the Paddock to take in atmosphere. We always have great fun at these events while making money for DHORC, keeping our membership fees low for all.






11.Possible Sprint Races at the end of Carrera Digital evening

Garbett reaches first half dozen with second hattrick

Dean Garbett and his pink pig Porsche 911 are so well matched to Sebring he seems to be able to win with ease as he took his sixth win from seven starts and second straight hattrick (Rounds 5,6 and 7). Again, he wasn't the quickest on track, setting the second fastest lap, but his strategy of taking early pit stops and just keeping up a good average pace took him to a 3.3 lap win.

From fifth on the grid **Nick Sismey** held off the fastest racer in Round 7, and second on the grid, **Angus Smith** by a mere 0.2 Laps, so closely were they matched. Fellow Group A racer **Steve White** kept his fourth place grid slot through to the flag two laps further back.

Geoff Peach was the first of the drivers outside Group A taking the Group B win on his way to fifth overall ahead of fellow Group B racer Phil Rees who was the last of the 70+ Lap racers in the first Club Night of the night.



Dave Edwards is really enjoying Carrera Digital with seventh here, showing he is getting to terms with the complexity of lane changes and pit stops like so many others. He was just 1.4 Laps behind Phil and 1.2 Laps ahead of **Lewis Blacker**, with **Martin Thorpe** making it five Group B racers in a row, 5.1 laps further back.

New member **John Yates** in his first Club Night race took Group C honours and rounded out the top ten by just 0.4 laps from fellow Group C racer **Richard Booth**.



Laura Edwards and Stuart Gray may have been in separate Groups but there was just 0.1 Laps between the two at the end of 15 minutes, leaving them in 12th and 13th.

John Lamb recorded his first Pole Position, thanks to his fastest lap in Round 3 back in January. He had not been able to take the benefit of it in the February evening due to COVID however, luckily for him, no-one beat his time in Rounds 4,5 or 6 so he sat on Pole for Round 7. Unfortunately, he wasn't able to take the benefit from it as car problems dropped him to 14th. Macaully Dutson had only had five minutes practice (including two minutes of Qualifying) before Round 7 so to record 40.6 Laps having never raced Carrera Digital before was a great start!

Dave Edwards had his best Carrera Digital finish in Round 8 with fifth

Sismey hits top spot with first max point score

Nick Sismey became the first DHORC Carrera Digital racer to take a max 45 points score with his first win and fastest lap. Seven time winner **Dean Garbett** was hot on his heels throughout with an incredible 0.1 Laps separating the two at the end. Had Dean taken a quicker splash and dash pit stop at the end he would have taken the win as he finished on 14% fuel, Nick 7%. **Steve White** was back on the podium for the second time, his first win can't be far away.



Geoff Peach again won the Group B battle keeping his hopes up in the Group Challenge. Dave Edwards went two better here than Round 7 with an incredible 5th overall. Will he and Geoff be fighting for Group A honours at Sakhir?

John Lamb made much better use of his second straight Pole Position by taking sixth this time, eight places better than Round 7. He was a mere 0.6 laps behind Dave and an even smaller 0.4 Laps ahead of **Lewis Blacker** who is moving his Ferrari up the grid.

Less than a lap further back was Group C winner Liam Smith in 8th, five places better than his previous best, in his first race of the night, He just (0.3 laps) beat the second quickest driver in Round 8 Angus Smith who admitted that he needs to change his driving style with Carrera Digital to improve his finishing record. Despite that he remains the Number 1 ranked racer in the category.

Chris Cooper was back for Round 8 taking the grid to 17. He would beat seven fellow racers with 10th here but should have been higher up had he not continued to enter the pits in 6th gear rather than 1st, costing him track time and laps! He just beat **Richard Booth**, who matched his Round 7 result, by the smallest of margins, 0.1 Laps



Martin Thorpe dropped three places compared to Round 7 with 12th here exactly a lap behind Richard. Martin was running his own Ferrari for the first time however, so was getting used to it. Stuart Gray and Laura Edwards again had a great battle despite again being in separate Groups. This time Stuart got the upper hand by 0.4 Laps to take 13th.

John Yates wasn't able to match his Round 7 result, nor was Phil Rees as they dropped to 15th and 16th respectively for different reasons. Macaully Dutson again reached 40 laps, just 0.6 fewer than Round 7. His new pink pig has since arrived so am sure he will be recording more laps at Sakhir.

Garbett, king of Sebring

Dean Garbett finished the nine Sebring races just as he started with his seventh win of the year, so keeping the Carrera Digital hattrick ball, having recorded a double hattrick at the venue! He maintains the lead in both Championships but still remain second in the Ranking charts by a mere 0.148 points thanks to **Angus Smith** setting a new track record with his sixth fastest lap! This counteracted Angus' ninth place finish here. Results must turn things around in Dean's favour at Round 10. **Nick Sismey** recorded his most race laps (78.4) to date to take second, 0.8 laps shy of Dean. Only Dean had recorded more laps at Sebring, his record being 81.6 in January. **Steve Smith** secured his third, third place on the rostrum. Can't wait to for Sakhir to see if it shakes up the running order and we get another new winner!



Phil Rees had a much better Round 9 than Round 7 and 8 getting to within 0.5 Laps of Steve and winning Group B, his second career Group win. Likewise, **Chris Cooper**, having changed his driving style, particularly his pit lane entry speed, reaped the rewards of a first Group C win and fifth overall, six places better than his previous best. What a great way to finish at Sebring!

Dave Edwards kept up his performance from Round 8 dropping just one place to sixth 0.3 laps behind Chris. So close was the midfield that **Geoff Peach** and **Liam Smith** were only 0.2 Laps further back in joint 7th, Liam improving his career best finish by another placing.

Angus was certainly out of position again 0.2 Laps further back, just managing to keep his top Ranked placing with his record lap of Sebring. With nine racers recording 70+ laps, tenth placed **Richard Booth** (his best finish of the night) was only 0.9 Laps from adding to that group. His 69.1 laps were only 1.9 laps behind fifth placed Chris, showing that a couple of extra seconds in the pit stops can make such a difference to your finishing place.



Martin Thorpe improved on his Round 8 finish by one place here, with 11th, his extra 3.4 Laps securing his placing in a higher scoring race. From his third straight Pole John Lamb again couldn't match the cars original speed, lapping nearly a second slower, as he took home 12th.

Stuart Gray recorded a hattrick of 13 place finishes on Tuesday night. He was just 0.4 Laps behind Razor but 1.7 ahead of Lewis Blacker who dropped back from his two excellent results in Rounds 7 and 8. John Yates equalled his Round 8 placing of 15th here, five down from his best start to his Carrera Digital career of 10th in Round 7. Laura Edwards was just 0.6 Laps further back while Macaully Dutson added 5.1 Laps to his best finish to take a third Wooded Spoon of the night, however improvements can certainly be seen. Watch out all at Sakhir.

Circuit History

The **Bahrain International Circuit** is a 5.412 km (3.363 mi) motorsport venue opened in 2004 and used for drag racing, GP2 Series (now FIA Formula 2), and the annual Formula One Bahrain Grand Prix. The 2004 Grand Prix was the first held in the Middle East. Beginning in 2006, Australian V8 Supercars raced at the BIC, with the event known as the Desert 400. However, the V8 Supercars did not return for the 2011 V8 Supercar season. 24 Hour endurance races are also hosted at BIC. The circuit has a FIA Grade 1 license. The circuit also has multiple layouts.

The construction of the Bahrain circuit was a national objective for Bahrain, initiated by the Crown Prince, Shaikh Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa. The Crown Prince is the Honorary President of the Bahrain Motor Federation. TRL was asked to build the circuit, headed by Patrick Brogan.

Race organizers were worried that the circuit would not be complete in time for the 2004 Bahrain Grand Prix and attempted to cancel the event; however, Formula One supremo Bernie Ecclestone refused this request. In the end, the circuit was not quite fully complete, but was good enough for the grand prix to go ahead.





