












### Editor

We have included the four proposed new tracks for 2023 from Page 5. We need to discuss it at the AGM, but we are looking to run two Club Nights on each of these tracks in 2023 and then run the four 2022 tracks from Evening 9 to 12 at the end of the year.





With thanks to Phil and Razor we now have a fantastic new cupboard in the Table Tennis room to store both our HO and Carrera equipment.






### 5. DHORC at Donington Park British GTs – 29May22

We were amongst the real GTs at Donington Park on 29May with our 8-lane HO track last weekend. Full update will be in the next HO magazine




### 6. Next circuit, Daytona Infield finalised - 132' 2"


### **Angus takes back to back wins**

Angus Smith backed up his win in Round 12 with this third Carrera Digital win in Round 13 seven weeks later. Unfortunately, eight time race winner Dean Garbett couldn't make the rearranged Evening 5 as it was his mum's 89<sup>th</sup> birthday, although sadly he even missed that as his wife caught COVID! The only silver lining was that it gave others a chance for victory, which Angus pounced on. From his fourth straight Pole (no-one has beaten Angus' sub 10 second lap since Qualifying in March) he fought the much happier Simon Goodlip, whose recent test at Phil Rees' gave him far more confidence with his Porsche 911. Just 1.4 laps separated our current and former HO Champions. This was Simon's best result to date beating his previous best of third on 12Apr22, his second in fastest lap was also a three place improvement for him. It was also Angus' fifth fastest lap in a row.



Phil Rees, winner at Round 4, led home six racers clumped together covered by two laps, to take his third podium of the year. He also took home the full six points for winning Group B. **Lewis Blacker** was driving well above his Group C qualifying place taking fourth overall just 0.2 laps behind Phil after 15 minutes of racing and at least 6 fuel stops, equalling his best career finish! **Chris Cooper** followed him home in fifth, matching his best finish, 0.7 laps back. Two Group C racers in the top five, just shows the depth of racing we have at DHORC!

Our third Group 1 racer **Steve White** was just 0.1 laps behind Chris, incredible how close the results are in the midfield! **Geoff Peach** started Round 13 from his best grid position to date, second, after his superb lap time set in Round 12. This was four places better than his previous best. He would take seventh alongside **Nick Sismey** who finished on the same lap and tenth.



As it was his first race at Sakhir, **John Lamb** had to qualify before the race started. His 11.485 second lap placed him in seventh overall and second on the Group B grid. Stuart Gray and Macaully Dutson shared his qualifying two minutes, however, couldn't improve on their scores. Razor would finish 0.3 laps behind Nick in ninth with **Martin Thorpe** rounding out the top ten, half a lap back.

**Richard Booth** finished on the same lap as Martin, 0.6 laps back around the 135'9" track. **Lee Pateman** was in the top three regarding fastest lap, but he is still looking for consistency from his USA Lambo, being the first to drop below 60 laps in 12<sup>th</sup>. **Liam Smith's** similar Huracan took him to 13<sup>th</sup> exactly a lap behind Lee.

**Stuart Gray** and **Macaully Dutson** rounded out the field and Group C with 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> respectively, Macaully still looking for that 50 plus lap score.



### **Rees doubles up on Digital wins**

Phil Rees backed up his first win at Sebring in Round 4 with his second Carrera Digital win in Round 14 at Sakhir, also winning Group B. Thanks to a car issue in Group A time was lost on the track for these five drivers. However, after their 15 minute race ended Phil was able to work out from the SmartRace app that just over 30 seconds of racing had been lost. We therefore added three laps to everyone's score in Group A. This brought Round 13 winner, Angus Smith's score up to 68.7 laps, 0.5 laps shy of Phil's score. Phil's win was also helped by Angus forgetting to plug his controller in at the start, losing him nearly a lap. Angus started Round 14 from his fifth Pole in a row and he set his sixth fastest lap in a row! Steve White matched his best result at DHORC with third, just 0.8 laps behind Angus as he continues to knock at the door of the top two.



**Lewis Blacker** also matched his best result to date with back to back fourth, his third to date, as all three groups were again represented in the top four places. Just 0.2 laps separated him from a podium placing! Martin Thorpe went one better than his previous best finish in February, with fifth here, just half a lap away from the bottom step of the podium.

**John Lamb** recorded his best result of the night with sixth, a mere tenth of a lap behind Martin. **Nick Sismey** just held off **Simon Goodlip** for seventh. At his first pit stop Nick decided to go for full brakes. While this immediately gave him his first sub eleven second lap at Sakhir, he could do

a single guick lap but just couldn't keep his Porsche 911 on the track long enough to challenge for a podium spot. Simon set the second fastest lap of the race for the second race running but found himself behind Nick in eighth.



Geoff Peach led home a racer from each Group with ninth, followed by Liam Smith and Chris Copper in 10th and 11th, 3.6 laps separating the three Groups. With eleven drivers recording 60+ laps, the same as Round 13, it was again Lee Pateman ahead of the rest in 12th.

Richard Booth dropped two spots to 13th, 1. 5 laps ahead of brother-in-law Stuart Gray. Macaully **Dutson** celebrated his first 50+ lap score at the back of the field with his Porsche 911 pink pig.



### **Angus leads Sakhir win chart with his 4th victory**

Angus Smith was back at the top of the podium in Round 15, his fourth win at Sakhir. From his sixth pole position in a row, he held off a hard pushing Simon Goodlip, who is finally happy with his Porsche 911, his first win not being far away. Simon matched his best career finish to date just 0.3 laps behind Angus, who took his seventh straight fastest lap. Our new Championship leader also took maximum Group points on the night to match Geoff Peach's Sakhir score in April.

Martin Thorpe also said he is now getting in the groove with these Carrera Digital GTs as he took his first podium place, beating his best result to date in the previous round, 5<sup>th</sup>. He became only the sixth racer to crack the 70+ lap score at Sakhir. His 11.128 second lap was also the 5<sup>th</sup> best in Round 15, beating his previous best of 6<sup>th</sup> in February!



Steve White couldn't quite match his Round 14<sup>th</sup> result, with 0.7 laps separating him and Martin. Nick Sismey, with his brakes readjusted to around 80% thought he had Martin in his sights in Group B, but the latter was always in control, taking 1.6 laps out of the former, still his best score at Sakhir! Nick's five Group B points would take him to the top of the Group Challenge. Chris Cooper also set his best lap score at Sakhir to secure sixth just 0.3 laps ahead of Round 14 winner Phil Rees.

#### 2022 - Derby Leisure & Events Venue HO Slot Car Club's 31st Season - 2022

**John Lamb** was pretty consistent at Sakhir's Evening 2, with 9<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and here 8<sup>th</sup> just 0.2 Laps behind Phil. He held off **Geoff Peach** by 1.9 laps, both taking three Group points in the process. **Lewis Blacker** was second behind Chris in Group C for 10<sup>th</sup> but a slim 0.2 laps ahead of Group B racer **Liam Smith**.



**Richard Booth** again had the pace to head off **Stuart Gray** for 12<sup>th</sup> although 13<sup>th</sup> was Stuart's best result of the evening. **Lee Pateman** set his fastest ever lap at Sakhir here, but again couldn't get his Lambo to keep all four wheels on the black top long enough to challenge a top placing. A change in car for Daytona is in the offing. **Macaully Dutson** however is going the other way adding another 3.1 laps to his previous best score as he looks to take himself off the bottom rung. Round 15 saw the most overall laps run at Sakhir, 982.9, beating the previous record of 971.0 laps at Round 12 (where we also had 15 racers). Just goes to show everyone is upping their game!



### **Circuit History**

The **Bahrain International Circuit** is a 5.412 km (3.363 mi) motorsport venue opened in 2004 and used for drag racing, GP2 Series (now FIA Formula 2), and the annual Formula One Bahrain Grand Prix. The 2004 Grand Prix was the first held in the Middle East. Beginning in 2006, Australian V8 Supercars raced at the BIC, with the event known as the Desert 400. However, the V8 Supercars did not return for the 2011 V8 Supercar season. 24 Hour endurance races are also hosted at BIC. The circuit has a FIA Grade 1 license. The circuit also has multiple layouts.

The construction of the Bahrain circuit was a national objective for Bahrain, initiated by the Crown Prince, Shaikh Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa. The Crown Prince is the Honorary President of the Bahrain Motor Federation. TRL was asked to build the circuit, headed by Patrick Brogan.

Race organizers were worried that the circuit would not be complete in time for the 2004 Bahrain Grand Prix and attempted to cancel the event; however, Formula One supremo Bernie Ecclestone refused this request. In the end, the circuit was not quite fully complete, but was good enough for the grand prix to go ahead.





