










Editor










4. New Circuits for 2024




5. Packing away is getting quicker!



Angus takes back to back wins again

Angus Smith repeated his Round 12/13 back to back wins by doing the same at Round 16 having won Round 15 in May, from a record seventh consecutive pole. It would also be a record fifth Group win in a row as he continues to dominate the Sakhir track. Eight time winner **Dean Garbett** was back after missing the previous evening and was immediately Angus' biggest rival from second on the grid. Angus would however take his fifth career victory by 2.1 laps adding 0.1 laps to his Sakhir laps record in the process. He also made it eight fastest laps in a row.

Steve White took his sixth third place finish in Round 16 as he continues to knock at the door of the top two, just 1.2 laps in arrears. The top five places of Round 16 were held by Group A racers with four time DHORC HO Champion Simon Goodlip getting closer to the top of the pile. Martin Thorpe in fifth continues to get more and more comfortable with his car. Once he has the SmartRace Connect app and can tweak his brakes I'm sure he will also be back in the top three.

Phil Rees lead home Group B in sixth, his fifth Group B win of the year plus the one Group A win. **Nick Sismey**, still playing with his brakes on the app, fell just 0.1 laps short of Phil as they battle to beat each other. **Dave Edwards** took his best result of the night, eighth after a splendid battle with **Liam Smith**, 0.9 laps the gap at the flag.

Richard Booth took his best career grid slot with 11th, one better than his previous best, 12th, set at the first evening of the year in January. He would round out the top ten with a lonely run nearly two laps behind Liam and 2.1 laps ahead of Lewis Blacker who had to change to his red Porsche 935 as his McLaren just wouldn't run at speed whatever he tried to do. The race was restarted to allow him to make the change as it had only been running for a couple of minutes! The race was halted halfway through again though when someone from the previous race hadn't switched off the SmartRace Connect app and inadvertently hit the big red stop button in their pocket. A reminder to switch the app off after your race!

Laura Edwards was back after a two evening sabbatical and was keen to race for the first time at Sakhir. She was straight into the frying pan running one Group up, the B, as her Group C had already run prior to her arrival on the back of Dave's motorbike. Laura showed what she could do, repeating it later, by beating everyone in Group C from the foot of Group B. She would also set the 12th fastest lap of the night, one better than her previous best in March

Stuart Gray opened his Evening 6 account with the first Group win of his career, by 0.4 laps from the returning **Richard Hill**, who we hadn't seen since February. The latter ran a similar Porsche 935 to Lewis' spare car. It was the first time 935s had been run at DHORC and suddenly there were two! Stuart's excellent first Group win also rewarded him with the 11th fastest lap, two better than the 13th he set back in February.

Macaully Dutson is starting to get used to his Porsche 911 as he qualified in a grid slot two places higher than his previous best of 15th in March. He would again hit the 50 lap mark in the race, being just 1.7 and 1.3 laps behind Stuart and Richard respectively.

Round 16 saw new Member **Daniel Kalyan** start his first race at DHORC after two test nights at Phil's man cave. Having qualified with an 18.737 second lap he immediately took 1.5 seconds off that time during the race with a 17.270 second lap. A great start of hopefully a great career.


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Angus becomes second racer to take a hattrick

Angus Smith became the second Member to take three consecutive Club Night wins at Round 17 after taking wins at both Rounds 15 and 16. However he doesn't get to keep the match ball as he didn't win all three races on one night like **Dean Garbett** did at Evening 1. Dean was again Angus' nearest rival and even beat the latter's race laps track record by 0.4 laps but that was still only good enough for second again! The reason? Angus added 1.1 laps to his record to secure his second win of the night, third in a row and sixth Group win in a row, a Club record. This was all from his record eighth consecutive Pole where he added his ninth fastest lap in a row. Taking six wins out of nine at Sakhir he is one short of Dean's seven at Sebring, with one race to go!

Only these two hit the 70+ lap mark this time, with Simon Goodlip and Phil Rees both in the 69s,





0.3 laps separating the two. It was Phil's second Group B final win of the night. While he only beat one Group A racer at Round 16, he beat three here. **Steve White** had been third in Round 16, but he dropped to fifth here a mere 0.1 laps more than **Nick Sismey** who was still tweaking his brakes more and more to full brakes. One more notch for Round 18 eh!



Liam Smith got everything together in Round 17 to take an excellent seventh overall, exactly a lap behind Nick, beating the final Group A driver **Martin Thorpe** by 1.4 laps in the process. Just one miss fuel or crash can make so much difference in such a close field.

Dave Edwards and Lewis Blacker fought it out for third place in Group B and ninth overall. So matched were they during the whole 15 minutes that they finished on the same lap and tenth at the flag, with Dave's Lamborghini just a car's length ahead of Lewis' back up Porsche as indicated by the green highlight in the results!

Despite recording more laps in Round 17 than 16 Richard Booth dropped one place to eleventh as everyone else improved. There were 44.3 laps more recorded across the field in the second race of the night compared to the first! Richard's brother-in-law Stuart Gray added nearly eight laps to his Round 17 score but needed to as Laura Edwards was back in Group C from Group B and improved her score by nearly three laps and she had been way ahead of Stuart in the previous race. Just 0.9 laps secured Stuart back to back Group wins for the first time. However he would have be on guard in the final round of the evening as Laura set the 11th fastest lap of the race here, one better than her previous best set in Round 16.

32nd stalwart **Richard Hill** was struggling with original tyres on his Porsche 935 as the better racing ones wouldn't fit without the ridges on his rear wheels being filed down. So he was still running lower in the rankings than would be normal. However he still added six laps to his result in the first race, again taking 14th. **Macaully Dutson** maintained his 50+ lap score, improving 1.5 laps from the previous race to take 15th for the eighth time in a row. He did however improve on his best fastest lap placing by two places, leaving himself 12th here!

While **Daniel Kalyan** wasn't surprised to be 16th again in Round 17 he did improve on his first 15-minute dash, adding 4.1 Laps to his best score but more impressively taking a fantastic 1.925 seconds off his best lap time! Thirty minutes in and his confidence is building!



Garbett makes it a record ninth win!

Dean Garbett mustered up all his strength and skill to overcome **Angus Smith** for the second time on the Sakhir desert circuit after his win in Round 11. Having beaten Angus by 1.6 laps in the April race there was only 0.2 laps between them this time. In fact, at one point we thought Angus had actually won as when the app switched the power off it showed Dean on 73.0 laps to Angus' 73.8 laps. Then we realised Dean was finishing his 73rd lap when everything switched off leaving him to coast over the line and take his 74th lap. Dean's record ninth win was certainly one of his closest. Angus took his record ninth consecutive (and record 12th all-time) Pole and tenth consecutive (and record 15th all-time) fastest lap on the way to second place. Dean dominated Sebring, Angus Sakhir, who will it be at Daytona?



Simon Goodlip matched his Round 17 finishing place with third here as well, recording two laps more and making the 70+ laps squad. In fact Round 18 saw twice as many racers hitting the 70+ laps score than Round 16 and three times those recorded in Round 17, with the top six in that bracket here.

Steve White set his best laps of the evening in Round 18 but could only record his second best result of the night with fourth 0.2 laps behind Simon. However his 10.666 lap time was the second quickest of the round, beating his previous best of third back in February at Sakhir. **Nick Sismey** secured the top five spots for Group A with his best run of the evening, now with full brakes



Again it was Phil Rees who broke up Group A before they could all get over the line, with his third Group B win of the night, and sixth overall. This matched both Angus and the absent Geoff Peach's feat of taking all three Group wins at previous Sakhir evenings. Group A's Martin Thorpe came in seventh this time, 0.6 behind Phil. This was the only blip in a uniform finishing line up with Group B taking the next four places and Group C the remaining five.

Second in Group B and eighth overall was Lewis Blacker a mere 0.3 laps ahead of Liam Smith with Richard Booth only 0.5 laps ahead of Dave Edwards to take 10th overall.

Laura Edwards first career Group win saw her record 0.1 laps more than **Stuart Gray** did in Round 17. However this time he was 1.4 laps down on that score as Laura became our 16th Member to win a Group since we started racing in January.

Richard Hill, **Macaully Duston** and **Daniel Kalyan** again found themselves in 14th, 15th and 16th positions for the third race in a row. However all three continued to improve round by round. Daniel recorded his first 40+ laps and Macaully took the 11th fastest lap time beating his previous best of 12th set at the last round. Richard will also come into his own once he has his car sorted out.

There were thirteen personal best improvements at Sakhir on Tuesday night, so it goes to show that more track time equals better results. There were 6.2 laps added to the overall Round 17 lap score in Round 18.


With apologies for not spotting it before I found an error in the Driver Ranking spreadsheet. It is always easier to spot things on a complicated spreadsheet when there is more data. I noticed that some racers who were clearly improving weren't actually moving up the charts. Digging further I spotted one line on the six worksheets across the two spreadsheets had an error meaning some racers were getting other racers' data and visa versa so some were improving where they shouldn't, and some were getting worse where they shouldn't.

As you can see this error has been present since before the end of Round 9 as the "Original Ranking" was what we published at the end of March, whereas it should have been the "Corrected Ranking". Green relates to the original data or placing being correct, red incorrect.

All of the attachments following this page are correct now, but most of them in Evening 3's magazine would have been wrong. The movement up or down the ranking (Green Arrow = Improvement, Red Arrow = Deterioration, Blue Arrow = No Change) is based on today's "Driver Ranking" shown on the left below compared to the "Corrected Ranking" in the middle.

Pleased I found it when we have only 22 racers over 18 Club Nights, it would have been a nightmare on the same HO spreadsheet which has 308 racers and 644 Club Nights.

Circuit History

The **24 Hours of Daytona**, also known as the Rolex 24 At Daytona for sponsorship reasons, is a 24-hour sports car endurance race held annually at Daytona International Speedway in Daytona Beach, Florida. It is run on the Sports Car Course layout, a 3.56-mile (5.73 km) combined road course, utilizing portions of the tri-oval and an infield road course. Since its inception, it has been held on the last weekend of January or first weekend of February as part of Speedweeks, and it is the first major automobile race of the year in North America. The race is sanctioned by IMSA and is the first race of the season for the IMSA SportsCar Championship.

The race has had several sponsors names over the years. Since 1992, the Rolex Watch Company is the title sponsor of the race under a naming rights arrangement, replacing Sunbank (now SunTrust) which in turn replaced Pepsi in 1984. Winning drivers of all classes receive a Rolex Daytona watch.

The race has been known historically as a leg of the informal Triple Crown of endurance racing.





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
