




Angus makes it four in a row with record 10th win

Angus Smith continued where he left off last week with his fourth straight win at Daytona, the first Member to win four consecutive Club Nights/Rounds. This takes him to ten career wins, one ahead of **Dean Garbett** who dominated the early Rounds of the Championship. Angus also set his 14th consecutive fastest lap, with a new Daytona track record, beating his previous best by 0.089 seconds. More records for the books. Dean was his closest rival in the race to the flag, from fourth on the grid, 1.6 laps the final gap.

Chris Cooper was beaming from ear to ear when he realised he had made the podium for the first time in 18 attempts. His previous best had been fifth in March. He also won Group B, taking home a maximum six points, two laps up on his nearest rival in the Group, Martin Thorpe. In between these two were Group C winner **Phil Rees**, just 0.3 laps down on Chris and **Lee Pateman**, a further lap down. Good to see these four all moving up the table. Phil a previous winner and the remaining three are all bound to be future winners!



John Lamb made it seven top ten finishes in a row with 7th here, sharing 66 laps with **Dave Edwards** and **Lewis Blacker**, 0.5 and 0.4 laps the gaps between them. **Liam Smith** rounded out the top ten, another 1.5 laps in arrears, Group C being the only Group to have four racers in the top ten.

John Yates made 11th his own with yet another performance gain. His seventh in the fastest lap table was three better than his previous best in March, dropping into the sub ten second laps for the first time! Eleven racers down and eleven to go with our largest grid to date!

Stuart Gray had his best run on Tuesday in Round 22, even beating son Thomas Gray, who was about to have a meteoric rise through the ranks. A final position of 13th for Thomas here was two better than he managed in his first evening a week earlier, as was 12th on the grid compared to a previous best of 14th.

One of the vagaries of having the start/finish line on a long curve, as is the real Daytona start/finish line, was the fact that if cars were drifting over the lap counting sensor, particularly on the outside lane, the sensor wasn't counting the laps. This caused some cars to miss laps, no more so than **Simon Goodlip's** Audi, resulting in a potential 20 lap deficit, leaving him in an unhappy 14th. We agreed that we would look into where to place the sensor for future Daytona evenings if folk used the inside lane more for future races on Tuesday night and even lifted slightly to make sure the car was straight. We had no further issues for the rest of the night.

Jag Kalyan and Macaully Dutson had their best runs of the evening in Round 22 with 15th and 16th respectively, a mere 0.2 laps separating the two. Laura Edwards' 17th meant she had not deviated more than one position over the last four Rounds, but things would change in the next Round.

Over the last five placings there were three competitors out of position. **Steve White's** 18th was a result of a motor change (Page 19) for his McLaren mid race. I must admit it was one of the quickest changes I have seen! **Geoff Peach** had an electrical problem with his Audi and withdrew after 49 laps! **Daniel Kalyan** beat new member **Simon Rankin**, who was using a Ferrari Club Car, by 0.2 laps to take 20th, while **Nick Sismey** recorded his first Wooden Spoon as his Porsche was also diagnosed as needing a new motor after his front wheel fell off a couple of times! A new motor was kindly provided and fitted by Angus for the rest of the evening and Phil used copious amounts of superglue on the wheel.





Steve White had to change a motor half way through Round 22, which put him in very good stead for Round 23, resulting in his very first win! Congrats Steve.

Race Report



Round 23 Daytona



Group D - Simon, Stuart Gray, Laura Edwards, Macaully Dutson and Jag Kalyan set the evening in motion.

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White takes first win with a tank full of air!

Steve White almost lost the chance of taking his first win as his fuel gauge almost reached zero and then he couldn't refuel right at the end of the race! Luckily there was just enough fuel in the tank to register his 78th lap as he entered the pits and the flag dropped just as he left the pits with an empty tank. Another five seconds and **Angus Smith** would have closed the 0.4 lap deficit.

Naturally Steve was euphoric after getting over the last lap panic and becomes our fifth Carrera Digital winner at his 23rd start. To quote Steve, "About time, it took me long enough!" Which just goes to show the level of competition when it takes someone as good as Steve 23 goes to take a win! I'm sure his next one will be much sooner! His win was from a personal best (PB) second on the grid, his previous best being third in April, and his final position was two better than his six third places to date. **Dean Garbett** maintained his podium placings on the night with third, 0.9 laps down on Angus as Group A dominated the rostrum. These three now have 20 of the 23 wins this year.



Simon Goodlip made it four Group A racers in the top four with his best result of the night. He also set his first career fastest lap, just 0.029 seconds quicker than Angus, after five second places.

John Yates must be close to his first podium with a fantastic fifth here, two places better than his previous best of seventh last week. He also took home his third Group win. **Phil Rees** matched John with a Group win, taking back to back Group C wins, but dropping two places compared to Round 22. He almost matched John on laps, just 0.1 the deficit. Also on 72 laps was **Nick Sismey**, 0.3 laps back, his best run of the night.

Despite recording 0.8 laps more than in Round 22 Chris Cooper found himself in eighth in Round 23, so much had everyone else improved. Thomas Gray continued his meteoric climb up the final position table with another four place gain to ninth in only his fifth race. Lee Pateman rounded off the top ten, dropping five places from his excellent fifth in Round 22.

John Lamb took 11th in what would become his last race of the evening. Being incredibly consistent he recorded just 0.2 laps less than the previous Round and his Lambo almost rolled on enough when the power ebbed away to match Lee on 66.8 laps. **Lewis Blacker's** second in Group C left him a lap down from Razor in 12th, however he had to recover from losing a rear wheel during the race. He was followed home by fellow Group C racer **Liam Smith**, 1.2 laps the gap.

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



1.0 Club Night

Three evenings run on the same circuit, four circuits during the year.

1.1 Qualifying Round (Club Night) 1 at a new circuit - One flying lap at the Test Night preceding the first Club Night at a track. Those who miss Qualifying get an NT (No Time) and go to the foot of the table. However Groups for the three Rounds on the first evening on a new circuit are set based on Ranking.

Round 2 – Best lap from either Qualifying or Round 1.

Round 3 – Best lap from either Round 1 or Round 2

Round 4 (Different night) – Best lap from either Round 2 or Round 3, which also sets the Groups for the three Rounds on that night.

1.2 Race 15 minutes with 6 cars per race, with a minimum of two races for all competitors on the night (Depending on the number of competitors) Anyone can win overall from any Group, the winner recording the most laps plus tenths. Competitors on the same lap and tenth will get the same points.

Note: If a competitor arrives after the first Round of races have begun, they will have to wait for the Round to finish if there is no gap in the remaining Groups.

1.3 Points Points will be awarded down to 24th place for each Round as shown below with additional points awarded for the top five Fastest Laps. 65% of the Rounds run will count towards to the Championship so if a racer competes in all Rounds their best 65% of points will count.

There will also be a Championship based on Group Points with the same points awarded to A, B, C and D Groups, six down to one. All points to count.

2.0 Cars

Carrera GT2, GT3 and GTE Racing Cars

- **2.1 Bodies** No modification or floating body screws (latter to be reviewed at 2022 AGM)
- **2.2 Lights** Must be working. Older Evolution cars do not contain lights as standard so chipped lights would need to be fitted.
- 2.3 Aerials/Mirrors Can be removed
- **2.4 Rear Wings** Must be fitted at the beginning of the meeting. If they break off and can't be refitted, then the uprights must be replaced with rubber and fitted for the next meeting.
- 2.5 Chassis No modifications
- 2.6 Axles
 - **2.6.1 Front** Either standard Carrera or complete axle supplied by DHORC.
 - **2.6.2 Rear** Either standard Carrera or the following Slot.it Rear Axle Kit Pt No KK07C 28t Inline Crown with 17.3x9.75mm hubs.



As some cars require different size hubs it was agreed that the following parts, to make up the rear axle, could be bought separately if need be: -

Aluminium Hubs 17.3x9.75x1.5 Crown Gear 28Tooth Inline Bronze Bearings x2 Axle 54mm x1 Wheel Hub Spacers 1mm x 2

2.7 Front Magnet Must be removed

- **2.8 Tyres** Rear, standard or supplied by DHORC. Front, standard and must touch the track and rotate when the car is running. Both can be reprofiled.
- **2.9 Minimum Height** A minimum height between the base of the rear magnet holder and the provided Technical Plate agreed at **1mm**. This is because the rear magnet holders on different cars are closer to the track, giving better road holding. We want all cars to have the same level of road holding, so we can make all cars competitive.

3.0 Driving & Racing Standards (Based on The Digital Slot Car Association Rules)

3.1. Any car on the circuit must be compliant with the GT rules.

3.2. Any indiscretion against stated regulations will be punishable by penalty (to be agreed).

3.3. When lapping a slower car, it is the responsibility of the faster car to change lanes and perform an overtake. Lapped cars should remain in their current lane until the faster car has passed.

3.3.1. Intentionally blocking of a faster car when lapping is illegal

3.3.2. Intentionally blocking a car fighting for position on the same lap is allowed

3.4. Contact from cars racing on the same lane, in proximity, is to be expected. Intentional or excessive contact is not allowed. Penalties (to be agreed) will be issued in the following circumstances: -

3.4.1. Intentional or excessive contact with another car

3.4.2. De-slotting another car by driving into the back of it

3.4.3. Intentionally stopping on the circuit

3.4.4. Excessive blocking by changing lanes when being lapped

3.5. Illegal contact may be reported by any participant of the meeting

3.6. Cars may be requested to pit for attention under the following circumstances: -

3.6.1. Any functional or mechanical part of the car has become completely detached from the car

3.6.2. A wing or spoiler becomes broken, completely detached from the body, or it is clear to the official at race control that when viewing the car from their normal position, that it is damaged

3.6.3. The required number of headlights/taillights are not working

3.6.4. A car is otherwise causing a hazard that may damage the circuit or other cars on the circuit

3.7. If any session is paused (red flagged), the following restrictions apply: -

3.7.1. Cars must not be removed from the track, where they have come to stop

3.7.2. Any car in the pit at the time of the red flag must have no further work completed on it until the session is resumed

3.7.3. Drivers may leave their station only under the direction of race control

3.8. During Parc Ferme conditions, cars may only be worked on under the supervision of an official

3.9. Slow or malfunctioning cars should move to the inside lane (or lane nearest to the pit) and pit as soon as possible. Race control should be notified that there is a slow car on circuit so other drivers may be warned


Circuit History

The **24 Hours of Daytona**, also known as the Rolex 24 At Daytona for sponsorship reasons, is a 24-hour sports car endurance race held annually at Daytona International Speedway in Daytona Beach, Florida. It is run on the Sports Car Course layout, a 3.56-mile (5.73 km) combined road course, utilizing portions of the tri-oval and an infield road course. Since its inception, it has been held on the last weekend of January or first weekend of February as part of Speedweeks, and it is the first major automobile race of the year in North America. The race is sanctioned by IMSA and is the first race of the season for the IMSA SportsCar Championship.

The race has had several sponsors names over the years. Since 1992, the Rolex Watch Company is the title sponsor of the race under a naming rights arrangement, replacing Sunbank (now SunTrust) which in turn replaced Pepsi in 1984. Winning drivers of all classes receive a Rolex Daytona watch.

The race has been known historically as a leg of the informal Triple Crown of endurance racing.
