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
Race Report



Round 26



19th September 2023







Dean Garbett took his first win of 2023 at Round 26

Dean takes his first win of '23!


Dean Garbett brought his Porsche 911 RSR Pink Pig back to the fold and immediately had success taking his first win of 2023. Interestingly his penultimate win in 2022 came at the final Sakhir race on 21Jun22. While he dominated the early races in 2022 with the Pink Pig, that win was with his Audi R8 while his last win on 22Nov22 at Fuji was with another Porsche 911 RSR.

Dean's back to back wins at Sakhir (his third at the circuit) was thanks to a score of 74.5 laps, just 0.1 laps less than track record holder and Pole sitter (for the record 32nd time) **Angus Smith** who would take the first of three third placed finishes on the night. Finishing on 71.5 laps he was 2.1 laps behind Championship leader **Simon Goodlip** who took second with his 14th fastest lap (the only one to go sub 10 seconds). **JJ Hughes-Dowd** wasn't on top form on the night as he felt under the weather however he still made it four Group A racers in the top four, the only ones to record 70+ laps in the 15-minutes.





Macaully Duston and Andrew Staniec ran in the early Group E, Andrew winning all three.



Phil Rees lead home Group B taking his 7th Group win of the year, keeping atop the Group Challenge Championship. Five time HO Champion Lee Pateman finally got his Carrera Digital mojo back coming in sixth, a mere 0.1 laps behind Phil (a crash on the last lap in Turn1 preventing him at least equalling Phil's score). This gave Lee his first Group (C) win of the year, his last success on 25Oct22. Lewis Blacker and Tom Gray shared second in the B and seventh overall which meant the latter, second in the Group Challenge Championship, lost a point to leader Phil.



Gary Skipp's BMW came home in ninth recording 0.3 laps less than our joint seventh placers, with **Nick Sismey's** trusty Porsche 911 RSR, which has run in every Club Night, losing out to Gary by 0.9 laps. Had he not chanced his arm and tried to pit too late, with too little fuel, he may have done better, however it took him three pit stops before the SmartRace App would allow him to refuel. Lesson learnt – refuel when you have around 20% remaining! Luckily Nick was one of the five Group A racers who set the fastest five lap times in the race, so he added two points to his tally leap frogging Gary into ninth in the points at the first race of the Evening.

Martin Thorpe was uncharacteristically fourth in Group B, 0.3 laps behind Nick while "new kid on the block" Martin Allsopp won his first Group (D) race with his Ferrari, bought off and tweaked by Phil, by some margin. Clearly he was already ready for a higher Group, but he had to start somewhere. His years of HO racing had put him in good stead for his first Carrera Digital race. He would take home the maximum 11 Group points from 6th on the Group grid. Just 3.5 laps separated Lee at the top of the C and Jag Kalyan in second, yet there were six racers between them, Jag taking 13th.

Richard Booth felt he was ready for some new boots on his blue McLaren, as he had used the same ones from day one, however he still took 14th alongside Liam Smith, 1.5 laps behind Jag. Andrew Staniec continued his run of winning Group E, with his 8th consecutive victory, this time with his Ford GT. This was from a PB grid slot of 14th beating his previous best of 17th on 01Aug23. Mick Smith and son-in-law Lee Patterson had an incredible battle for top honours in the D had it not been for interloper Martin. However that same battle was for second in the Group, 17th overall, Mick taking it by just 0.3 laps.

Daniel Kalyan almost matched his dad on lap time, 0.05 seconds separating the two in speed. Just another 0.2 laps and he would have matched Lee. He was however 0.5 laps ahead of Stuart Gray, on a very busy 57 laps score. Macaully Dutson's Lambo in 2nd behind Andrew in the E gave him 21st overall. Dan Hughes-Dowd and Simon Rankin, both running Astons, battled it out for 22nd, the former snatching it by 0.1 laps. JT Hughes-Dowd's tail happy Porsche 935 brought him home in 24th, but there is work in the background to bring to the fore another Porsche 911 RSR Pink Pig, so watch out for JT in the future! Two of our Group D racers and one Group E racer set PBs in this race. Dan improved on his 16th grid position on 17Jan23 with 14th and Mick bested his 16th fastest lap on 09May23 with a 14th. Macaully's 10th in Qualy beat his 12th on 16Aug22.

Race Report



Round 27

Sakhir Control 19th September 2023



Group B were the first to race at 18:00 hours with Richard Booth, Tom Gray and the three Group winners Phil Rees, Martin Thorpe and Lewis Blacker



"What's the score Dan Hughes-Dowd?" – I thought he was watching Millwall against Newcastle, but Dan assured me it was AC Milan in the Champions League! Final score 0-0.

Simon takes 11th win of the year!

Simon Goodlip's lap time in Round 26 was good enough to give him Pole in Round 27, his 14th of the year (15th all time). He was able to convert this into his 11th win of 2023 (12th career) 0.3 laps behind **Dean Garbett's** Round 26 winning score and 0.4 behind **Angus Smith's** all-time record. Dean beat Simon by 0.9 laps in the previous Round, Simon beat Dean by 1.1 laps this time. Angus took back to back thirds, just 0.1 laps behind Dean, slashing the deficit across the podium finishers from three laps to just 1.2 laps this time. Angus also recorded a record 36th fastest lap.

Martin Thorpe corrected the wrongs of the previous Club Night moving up from 11th to take fourth with his eighth Group B win of the year. He was in a sea of Group A racers with friend and fellow non-magnet racer Gary Skipp just 0.2 laps behind Martin. He was followed home by Nick Sismey who had fixed his fuel issues (pitting with more fuel in the tank) from earlier as he shared sixth with Lewis Blacker. This was becoming a theme for Lewis on Tuesday night. He likes to share!





Jag and Daniel Kalyan had a good Evening, often finishing very close to each other.



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With 0.5 laps covering the previous four racers, 0.6 laps further back was Round 26's Group B winner Phil Rees, this time in third (8th overall) on 69.8 laps. There were two others in the 69 lap band, JJ Hughes-Dowd (in what would be his last race of the night as he felt too poorly to run later – get well soon JJ) dropping from fourth to ninth, 0.6 laps behind Phil and Lee Pateman (his second Group C win of the night) another 0.2 laps back rounding out the top ten. Liam Smith was going in the right direction, three places better than the first race of the night, taking 11th, second to Lee in the C.



Tom Gray continues to be the biggest thorn in Phil's Group Challenge hopes, but his fourth in Group B again lost him another point to Phil, the gap widening to 4.5 points. In 13th for the second race running was Jag Kalyan, despite a 1.8 lap improvement in the second race of the night. The competition seems to increase as the Evening progresses. After his 12th earlier it was 14th this time for Martin Allsopp, as he took back to back Group D wins. He only added 0.3 laps to his PB. Daniel Kalyan was much closer to his dad this time, being 7.2 laps behind him earlier here he was 2.3 laps behind, although the fastest lap time gap stretched out a little.

Richard Booth in 16th this time, dropping two places, knew new tyres were certainly required. Mick Smith matched his 17th place thanks to 3.3 laps more in Round 27 while Andrew Staniec continues to motor on in Group E, with his ninth straight win. Lee Patterson was second to Mick in Group D again, however the gap had widened from 0.3 to 3.0 laps. Stuart Gray rounded out the top twenty placings, 0.3 behind Lee. Somehow the twisty Sakhir track was not suiting his Ferrari as well as the two Brands Hatch circuits.

Macaully Dutson went a second quicker this time, adding 1.9 laps, but remained in 21st, knowing he can get more out of his car. JT Hughes-Dowd and Dan Hughes-Dowd also ran in their last race of the Evening swapping places, JT in 22nd this time, dad in 24th. JT added 7.4 laps in this 15 minute session while Simon Rankin's Aston again came home in 23rd sandwiched between the Hughes-Dowds.





It was a busy night with 24 on the grid, Lee Paterson, Liz Downes (there to support partner Lee and dad Mick), Martin and Mick Smith at the penultimate corner.



Simon Goodlip took two wins on the Evening, with Angus Smith on scrutineering duty and Lee Pateman having one of his best Evenings of the year.

Race Report



Round 28

Simon's bakers' dozen!

Simon Goodlip took his 13th career Carrera (trying to say that, sipping the winner's champagne!) Digital win in the final Round of the September Sakhir Evening. That makes it 12 wins for Simon from 28 starts this year compared to 1 from 27 last year, and we still have 16 races to go in 2023. This time Angus Smith laps record finally went, Simon adding 0.9 laps leaving it at 75.5 laps. However it wasn't Angus in second but Dean Garbett again, in his best night of the year, Angus yet again taking third. All three filled all three podium slots in all three Rounds at Sakhir.

While Simon took back to back Poles, his 14th of the year (15th career) and back to back wins noone took back to back fastest laps with Dean recording only the third sub 10 second lap time at Sakhir in this Round, Angus taking Round 26, Simon Round 27. This was only Dean's second fastest lap, and he has taken both of them this year, the last at Imola on 17Jan23. His 9.928 second lap is just 0.022 seconds off Angus' fastest lap around the Bahrain F1 circuit set on 29Mar22. This means Dean is guaranteed two Poles at the next Evening on 10Oct23 as he also set Pole for the Sakhir Outer Sprint Race circuit. That is of course if he turns up!

With only 21 on the grid, compared to the 24 in the earlier two races, due to the absence of the Hughes-Dowds there were only five racers in the A. They swept the top five places this time with **Nick Sismey** enjoying his best run on a track he, and many others, found fantastic to drive with its flowing corners and long straights. He was very pleased to be just 0.4 laps behind Angus although not has pleased as he thought he was going to be. On the screen Angus was 0.6 laps behind him, but like Simon he had to have a lap added to his score. Unfortunately folk are still going too quick into the pits which means the guide is missing the lane change close switch leaving it open for cars to hit, launching them into the air.



Gary Skipp matched his Round 27 fifth place adding 1.1 laps to his previous score, and guess what for third race in a row **Lewis Blacker** shared a placing with someone, this time Gary. His shared finishing places at Sakhir were 7th, 6th and now 5th. At this rate he should share the win at the second Sakhir Sprint Race on 10Oct23! Keep close to Lewis. He was the third racer on the night to win Group B. The other two winners followed him home, **Martin Thorpe** 0.7 laps behind with **Phil Rees** another 1.5 laps back. However, luckily for Phil **Tom Gray** was again one place behind him giving Phil another extra point towards the Group Challenge, his lead going up from 2.5 to 5.5 points over the course of the Evening.

Lee Pateman matched his tenth place in the previous Round despite dropping 0.1 laps He was certainly consistent with 0.7 laps covering his scores over the three races. Oddly, his worse score gave him his best result of 6th in Round 26. It was by far his best Evening of the year. **Liam Smith** fell smack bang in the middle of the field in 11th, 0.7 laps behind Lee, also matching his previous Round's placing. **Richard Booth** finally mastered the technique to get the best out of his McLaren's old tyres taking an Evening best of 12th.

Jag Kalyan made it three 13th place finishes in a row for the Evening, adding 2.4 laps across the three races. Martin Allsopp, taking all three Group D wins, matched Jag's laps and took home the maximum 33 Group points from D6. **Daniel Kalyan's** 15th meant the three of them were tied together for two races running. He was also very close to his dad again on lap times.

Andrew Staniec equalled JJ's consecutive Group win record with his 10th Group E win in a row, as he matched his 16th in Round 26. He also set the 17th fastest lap improving upon his 18th on 09May23. Stuart Gray recorded his best result of the Evening with 17th along with his fastest lap of the night.

Mick Smith and Lee Patterson had another close battle, with Lee actually setting a faster lap this time, but Mick taking 18th by 0.9 laps. Macaully Dutson went one better than his previous two finishes with 20th with Simon Rankin jumping two places to 23rd.





1.0 Evenings

Two Evenings run on the same circuit, seven Race and two Sprint circuits in 2023.

1.1 Race Groups

Up to a maximum of four Race Groups of six racers based on Ranking (last 9 Races) with the top six ranked racers in Group A, then Group B, Group C and Group D. If there are less than 24 racers on an Evening then the Race Groups will be adjusted accordingly as equally as possible. Group E has also been introduced to support racers who wish to run earlier between 17:00 and 18:00 hours.

1.2 Qualifying

One crash and burn lap at the end of that track's Test Night for the 1st Round at any track. For the 2nd Round on each circuit the fastest lap from either Qualifying above or the 1st Round. Thereafter the fastest lap from the last two Rounds for any subsequent Rounds.

This also reads across to Sprint Races on a shorter version of that circuit if that circuit is chosen to hold Sprint Races.

1.3 Race

15-minutes with a maximum of six cars per Race Group, with a minimum of three Races for all competitors on the night (Depending on the number of competitors) Anyone can win overall from any Race Group, the winner recording the most laps plus tenths. If more than one racer finishes on the same lap and tenth in any position it will be deemed a draw.

Races begin at 18:00 hours, racers to advise if they can't make it or will be late. We will do our best to ensure all racers run in all Races.

1.4 Race Points

Points awarded down to 24th place for each Race with additional points awarded for the top five fastest laps. 75% of the Club Nights run will count towards the Championship so if a racer competes in all Club Nights their best 75% of points will count.



A maximum of 5 grammes can to be fitted by doubled sided tape only.



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3.0 Driving & Racing Standards (Based on The Digital Slot Car Association Rules)

- 3.1. Any car on the circuit must be compliant with the GT rules.
- 3.2. Any indiscretion against stated regulations will be punishable by penalty (to be agreed).
- 3.3. When lapping a slower car, it is the responsibility of the faster car to change lanes and perform an overtake. Lapped cars should remain in their current lane until the faster car has passed.
 - 3.3.1. Intentionally blocking of a faster car when lapping is illegal
 - 3.3.2. Intentionally blocking a car fighting for position on the same lap is allowed
- 3.4. Contact from cars racing on the same lane, in proximity, is to be expected. Intentional or excessive contact is not allowed. Penalties (to be agreed) will be issued in the following circumstances: -
 - 3.4.1. Intentional or excessive contact with another car
 - 3.4.2. De-slotting another car by driving into the back of it
 - 3.4.3. Intentionally stopping on the circuit
 - 3.4.4. Excessive blocking by changing lanes when being lapped
- 3.5. Illegal contact may be reported by any participant of the meeting
- 3.6. Cars may be requested to pit for attention under the following circumstances: -
 - 3.6.1. Any functional or mechanical part of the car has become completely detached from the car
 - 3.6.2. A wing or spoiler becomes broken, completely detached from the body, or it is clear to the official at race control that when viewing the car from their normal position, that it is damaged
 - 3.6.3. The required number of headlights/taillights are not working
 - 3.6.4. A car is otherwise causing a hazard that may damage the circuit or other cars on the circuit
- 3.7. If any session is paused (red flagged), the following restrictions apply: -
 - 3.7.1. Cars must not be removed from the track, where they have come to stop
 - 3.7.2. Any car in the pit at the time of the red flag must have no further work completed on it until the session is resumed
 - 3.7.3. Drivers may leave their station only under the direction of race control
- 3.8. During Parc Ferme conditions, cars may only be worked on under the supervision of an official
- 3.9. Slow or malfunctioning cars should move to the inside lane (or lane nearest to the pit) and pit as soon as possible. Race control should be notified that there is a slow car on circuit so other drivers may be warned




Circuit History

The Bahrain International Circuit (Sakhir) is a 5.412 km (3.363 mi) motorsport venue opened in 2004 and used for drag racing, GP2 Series (now FIA Formula 2), and the annual Formula One Bahrain Grand Prix. The 2004 Grand Prix was the first held in the Middle East. Beginning in 2006, Australian V8 Supercars raced at the BIC, with the event known as the Desert 400. However, the V8 Supercars did not return for the 2011 V8 Supercar season. 24 Hour endurance races are also hosted at BIC. The circuit has a FIA Grade 1 license. The circuit also has multiple layouts.





