Great news, I personally follow NASCAR and my favourite driver Kyle Larson's No5 car looks like it may be in the first batch. We will have to discuss at the AGM whether to run a one off NASCAR race when cars are fully available.



Carrera Revell of Americas announces historic partnership with NASCAR. The American distributor will release slot cars in a new NASCAR category in 2024.





We already know the first cars which will be reproduced for slot racing. The agreement with NASCAR contains the license of the cars of **Team Hendrick Motorsports**, one of the most famous teams racing in NASCAR since 1984. So presumably, we can bet on four cars (5, 9, 24, 48) and only one mold, the Camaro.

This Carrera Revell partnership with NASCAR marks a new era for electric racing enthusiasts and collectors. The first models will be unveiled at the Nuremberg Toy Fair in 2024.

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6. Monza Banking

A massive thank you to **Phil Rees** and **Stuart Gray** for all of their hard work in producing the Monza banking. As I write three sets of banking are almost complete after three Friday afternoons of work plus work at home by Stuart making the majority of the wooden wedges.



15Sep23 – Phil and I used the DL&EV's van to pick up the wood required for the banking and Phil cut out the four bases. Seen here with the Zandvoort HO banking.



29Sep23 – Phil and Stuart started the build in earnest, working out how to support the first set of 6 off R4 banking piece, designing the wedges etc. There were a great deal of calculations made to ensure everything worked correctly. We even ran a couple of cars around the banking under power to make sure they negotiated the banking without any issues. Once everything was agreed Stuart then manufactured the wedges for the other three sets of banking at home.



06Oct23 – with all of the remaining 24 wedges completed by Stuart, he and Phil started on the remaining three sets of banking. As well as gluing and screwing the wedges in place, and making extra wedges for the end straights, which connect the curved sections. They also had to remove the excess base material. This virtually halved the weight of the bases.





Three of the banked corners are virtually complete. Two more Friday afternoons have been booked to finish them off and to complete the fourth turn. On the second of these Fridays we will also mock up the full track below to make sure it all works ready for the Test on 31Oct23.





Stop Press 13Oct23 – Phil was suddenly free this Friday afternoon (after the Sakhir Club Night) following a cancellation. We contacted Stuart and he was also free, so we were back in the Table Tennis Room again. Above, they started on the fourth set of Monza banking and below they sorted out all of the pieces making up the inside curve curbing – or playing Mahjong!





While they were doing the technical bit I loosely built up the track (without the red connectors to save time). We just about had enough track pieces even though the track length increased from the original 184'10" to 197'7". We just couldn't quite make it reach 200' and fit it in the room.



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The banking above, this end of the circuit will be raised by blocks to allow the cars to pass under. The drivers' platform will be placed over the wooden section behind the barrier so that all of the drivers will be able to see the first chicane behind the Turn 1 banking.





7. For DiSCA Le Mans read DSCA Paul Ricard - 2024

"New for the 2024 season is the DiSCA 24 hours of Paul Ricard! This event will temporarily replace the DiSCA Le Mans 24 hours as the organising team search for a suitable venue. The new event will take place on Circuit Paul Ricard located at DSCA Mechelen, Belgium, 22-23 June 2024.

The fantastic 4 lane Ninco recreation of Circuit Paul Ricard, built by the DSCA club in Mechelen, Belgium, will host the premier DiSCA 24h event in 2024. The event is being organised with the intention to run the event just once and return to the Le Mans 24h the following year. Registration will be expected to open at the start of November 2023 for a maximum of sixteen teams. 9. Extra Monza straights from Roger Barker Slots

We didn't quite have enough straights when we built Monza on Friday, so had to use some extra lane changers and power straights to make it work. The answer? A visit to Roger Barker Slots.



As soon as we realised were short on Friday we rang Roger, who immediately checked his stock. "I have 14, will that help?" he asked, "Too right it will" we said.

To cut a long story short **Phil Rees** and I popped over to his unit in Sutton on Trent on Saturday to pick up the track and have a wonder around his slot car grotto.

Just before we left Roger's mate, who manages most of the stock, heard we were looking for straights and found another 12! Swapping these 26 straights for some Tomy Lighted cars, plus Roger buying some additional cars, we left with more than enough extra straights to build Monza and £140 for the DHORC coffers.







Simon's hattrick on record attendance night!

Simon Goodlip took his second hattrick of wins for the year (and career) on Tuesday night, which saw a record grid of 28 starters. Having won the last two races at Sakhir on 19Sep23 he followed those up with the first win of the night in the October race. His 13th win of the year (14th career) saw him extend his Championship lead by nine points over second placed **Angus Smith** who dropped back 1.5 laps to take runner up spot. Without a failed pit stop (where he couldn't refuel) it may have been much closer.

Like many others on the night, for some reason, Lewis Blacker was stuck in traffic getting out of Wolverhampton. But like everyone else he arrived on time to race. And it was all worth it for him as he took a well-deserved third, just a lap behind Angus, his best result since his win in Round 14, and the Group B win. Nick Sismey, running in Group B for the first time this year, had two failed pit stops (stop going in too fast Sismey!) otherwise he would have challenged Lewis for that podium slot. He was 0.8 laps further back.







Dean Garbett made DHORC-CD history by becoming the first Member to score "Nul points" on Tuesday night as we had 28 racers for the first time, the points system goes down to 27th. Car problems saw him only record 11.9 laps. He did bounce back though!

Geoff Peach returned after a 10 Club Night sabbatical, running and winning Championships with his bowling teams, with a bang as he took the fastest lap of Round 29. He has clearly not lost any of his speed! This was only his second fastest lap after his first on 17Jan23. He finished a mere 0.1 laps behind Nick in fifth.

Gary Skipp would come into his own later in the Evening in the two Sprint Races. However even here he took sixth, half a lap behind Geoff. **Tom Gray** was on a mission on Tuesday night to take as many points as he could out of **Phil Rees** who led the Group Challenge by 5.5 points. Five points here was a very good start seeing as where Phil unfortunately finished! In seventh Tom was a lap ahead of joint eighth place finishers **JJ Hughes-Dowd** and **Martin Thorpe** both fighting for their places in Group A and Group B respectively. JJ was only beaten by Geoff in fastest laps!

Steve White's first race on Sakhir this year (as he was on hols for the last Evening) saw him round out the top ten just 0.1 laps behind his mate Martin and JJ. **Lee Pateman** was feeling good after the Sakhir Outer test and last Sakhir Evening, his Audi much more to his liking. Eleventh, 0.3 laps behind Steve was a great result after all the woes he had earlier in the year. It was also his fourth straight Group win of the year as he won the C.

Laura Edwards loves Carrera Digital, even more so when she beats hubby **Dave Edwards**. Here, in 12th, she was four places ahead of him, with exactly three more laps, as she took the D Final win. Between these two was eternal E Final winner (his 11th straight win) **Andrew Staniec**, whose 13th placed finish beat his previous best of 15th on 01Aug23. It was great to see all five Group winners in the top thirteen places, with three of them together. Shows the depth of racing in the Club. **Liam Smith** and **Richard Booth** were the other two in the Edward's sandwich, like Dave both in the C, making it a C 2nd, 3rd and 4th, 0.7 laps covering the three of them from 14th to 16th.

JT Hughes-Dowd recorded the most Group points in Round 29 with 10, finishing in D2 from a D5 grid slot. He was followed home by fellow Group D racers **Daniel Kalyan** and **Mick Smith**. While they were a lap behind JT only 0.2 laps separated them in 18th and 19th. Mick was just pleased to be there after an awful trip over from north Nottingham with major traffic delays.

Macaully Dutson had a great race with Andrew in the E, losing out by five laps in the end but knowing where he needed to improve as we reached our 20th finisher. **Jag Kalyan** was also delayed with his car in the garage but again made it on time to race. His 21st was three places behind a smiling son Daniel, but he was getting his eye in with a much quicker lap. **Martin Allsopp** moved up to Group C after winning all three Club Nights in Group D last time round. He would take 22nd.

Lee Patterson made a herculean effort to get there on Tuesday, along with Mick, taking 23rd just 0.8 laps behind long time racer Martin, and beating Stuart Gray by 0.7 laps. Stuart's efforts towards getting our Monza track up and running cannot be understated! Thank you Stuart. Dan Hughes-Dowd and Simon Rankin did DHORC a big favour, kindly agreeing to run in the early Group E, which means we can work towards our first ever grid of 30 racers. Thanks to them we had room for the record 28 starters at Sakhir. Dan took 25th 0.9 laps ahead of Simon.

Talking of woes earlier, **Phil Rees** and **Dean Garbett** had their fair share of those here with wiring issues affecting both of their cars. Phil's at least happened towards the end of the 15 minutes, on his 52nd lap, which mean he only took 1.0 Group points to Tom's 5.0. However Dean made DHORC history by becoming the first Member to finish a Club Night on zero points. His car gave up the ghost after a mere 11.9 laps. There was a silver lining for him however as he took his first Pole of the year and 4th career front row start, his last being on 16Aug23. This all took place during a Club Night that saw a record distance of 241,379 feet (46 miles) being registered.

Angus takes record 24th win as Group A dominates.

Angus Smith continues to lead the way in Carrera Digital career victories with his 24th win at Round 30, his eighth win of the year. He recorded exactly the same laps (73.7) as **Simon Goodlip** took to win Round 29 while Simon matched Angus' second place score of 72.2 laps in the last Round but this was only good enough for fourth this time! Liam Smith made it three straight Group C racers in a row when he took 17th while Daniel Kalyan made it a run of two straight Group D Members. He beat JT Hughes-Dowd by exactly a lap as JT shook down his Porsche Pink Pig for the first Evening, his 935 now parked in the pit garage. The name Andrew Staniec meant another Group E win (his 12th in a row) and he continues to torment his fellow Group racers even though he dropped from 13th to 20th. Mick Smith finished on the same lap as Andrew, 0.6 laps separating the two.

The next three racers were all in the 62 lap band, each separated by 0.1 laps. **Richard Booth** and **Jag Kalyan** brought Group D's efforts to a close in 22nd and 23rd. **Stuart Gray**, another 0.1 laps back in 24th matched his Round 29 result despite a 4.5 lap improvement. Behind these three was **Macaully Dutson**, in 25th, who reduced his deficit to Group E winner Andrew from 5.0 to 1.9 laps as he seeks his first victory over Mr Staniec.

Lee Patterson muscled his Mercedes into 26th with Dan Hughes-Dowd taking the last point of the Club Night 0.3 laps back in 27th. This meant it was Simon Rankin's turn to take "nil points", but with 1.7 laps more than the previous Race.

The Club Night distance record went for the second time here, leaving it at 256,683 feet (49 miles).





Group E – Dan Hughes-Dowd, Simon, Macaully Dutson & Andrew Staniec








SR3 Race Report

Dean's speedy transformation!

Dean Garbett transformed his night from a low, as the first ever Member to take 28th, to the ultimate high with his second win of the year, on the Sakhir Outer circuit. Our third Sprint Race, which was broken down into Groups of four cars for the 5-minute races rather than the six in the 15-minute Endurance Races saw our third Sprint Race winner, Dean having set a hattrick of Poles for the first time! Also setting back to back fastest laps for the first time he maxed out on points for the first time in his career. He was clearly in the zone as despite it being only a 5-minute race Dean beat fellow Group A racer **Angus Smith** by no less than 2.6 laps! That covered the top six in the last Round!

Angus made it three podium finishes from three starts at Evening 21 which was doing his points haul no harm at all. With **Simon Goodlip** changing car from the one he used in the earlier Endurance races he found himself down in an uncharacteristic 15th place, his worse finish of the year. This meant Angus took another 11.5 points out of his Championship lead, as Angus also set the third fastest lap. **Gary Skipp**, running in his first Sprint Race took an excellent third, winning Group B, with some very consistent driving. Having also Qualified in second at the Test Night he beat his previous best grid slot of fourth set on 04Jul23.





A great night for both Dean and Gary. After a first Race washout Dean took third and two firsts in the remaining Club Nights. Gary made it back to back thirds in both Sprint Races.

Incredibly just 1.3 laps covered the next nine racers which included three pairs of drivers sharing the same lap score. **Steve White** and **Lee Pateman** were the first pair, sharing fourth with 41.5 laps apiece, although Lee jumped one point ahead of Steve thanks to the fourth fastest lap point. Then came **Lewis Blacker** and **Tom Gray** both on 41.4 laps, sharing sixth place and 11.0 points each. Lee had won the D (his 6th straight Group win) while both Lewis and Tom won the D. This would give Tom an extra 2.5 points over his Group Challenge rival **Phil Rees** as he attempted to break Phil's stranglehold of top spot. To add to his good fortune Tom also recorded his best Qualifying position of 4th beating his 6th on 01Aug23 and he equalled his best ever finish.

A further 0.1 laps back was **Nick Sismey** who only just beat a buzzing **Laura Edwards** by 0.4 laps. She took her third Group win of the night, with ninth, equalling her best finish of the year. We still weren't done, there were still three left in this extraordinary band of warriors. Just 0.1 laps behind Laura, it was **Geoff Peach's** turn to round out the top ten with **Martin Thorpe** and Phil sharing 11th a piece. Wow these Sprint Races throw up some amazing results!

With a gap of 1.4 laps to the next sway of racers it was **JJ Hughes-Dowd** who led another six racers covered by just 1.6 laps from 13th place down. Martin Allsopp, half a lap behind JJ, usurped Simon, who wished he hadn't changed car, of 14th place by 0.1 laps, while Simon was 0.2 laps ahead of Group E winner **Jag Kalyan**, his fourth Group win of the year. Jag finally beat son **Daniel Kalyan** for the first time during the Evening, both pushing their Audi R8s to the limit. Just 0.8 laps separated them in 16th and 18th respectively with **Richard Booth** intersecting them, finishing exactly half way between the two.

Mick Smith, Dave Edwards and Liam Smith all finished with 36 laps in the books in 19th, 20th and 21st on the 6th, 4th and 3rd tenth respectively. It was incredible just how close folk finished to each other at the Sakhir Outer circuit. Andrew Staniec kept his Group winning streak going, this time in the G, recording win number 13, 0.7 laps behind Liam. JT Hughes-Dowd had again, for the second time on the night, to learn a new track with a new car, taking 23rd this time round.

Stuart Gray took his Ferrari into 24th, which would set him up for a better result in the next Round with Lee Patterson's Merc finishing in 25th, which would be his second best result of the Evening. It was then all Group G for the final three placings, Macaully Dutson not quite taking half a lap out of Simon Ranking while Dan Hughes-Dowd made it three different racers to take "sifr niqat" as they say in Bahrain.

Both Daniel and Richard did their fair share of marshalling taking home a 16th and 15th respectively.




Sprint Race Master Dean

Dean Garbett closed out a night that started so badly, so well, by taking both Sprint Race wins, the first time that has happened. He also secured all four Pole positions on the night more than doubling his original career total of three with seven now! He did the same with fastest laps, his third straight fastest lap taking his career total from two to five. Dean's 46.2 laps here beat his 46.0 in the previous race, and he therefore holds both Sakhir Outer track records. Some night for Dean! These results also take him from fifth to third in the Championship!

Angus Smith completed a clean sweep of all four podiums on the night with a win and three second places. Despite Angus improving on his previous Sprint Race score by 0.2 laps he would still finish 2.6 laps behind Dean again as the latter improved by the same margin. **Gary Skipp** made sure the two Sprint Race podiums mirrored each other by again taking third and again taking the Group B win. He reduced his margin to Angus from 1.1 to 0.8 laps though. Championship leader **Simon Goodlip** improved his lot in the second Sprint Race moving up from 15th to 7th compared to the first. However this meant Angus still took a further seven points out of his lead, which during the night reduced from 61 points to 20 points. After the first Club Night at Evening 22 (Daytona) we reach 33 Club Nights so scores start to be dropped in line with the 75% rule. 





- **2.11 Min Height** A minimum height between the base of the rear magnet holder and the provided Technical Plate agreed at **1mm**. This is because the rear magnet holders on different cars are closer to the track, giving better road holding. We want all cars to have the same level of road holding, so we can make all cars competitive.

2.12 Chassis Weights

A maximum of 5 grammes can to be fitted by doubled sided tape only.



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3.0 Driving & Racing Standards (Based on The Digital Slot Car Association Rules)

3.1. Any car on the circuit must be compliant with the GT rules.

3.2. Any indiscretion against stated regulations will be punishable by penalty (to be agreed).

3.3. When lapping a slower car, it is the responsibility of the faster car to change lanes and perform an overtake. Lapped cars should remain in their current lane until the faster car has passed.

3.3.1. Intentionally blocking of a faster car when lapping is illegal

3.3.2. Intentionally blocking a car fighting for position on the same lap is allowed

3.4. Contact from cars racing on the same lane, in proximity, is to be expected. Intentional or excessive contact is not allowed. Penalties (to be agreed) will be issued in the following circumstances: -

3.4.1. Intentional or excessive contact with another car

3.4.2. De-slotting another car by driving into the back of it

3.4.3. Intentionally stopping on the circuit

3.4.4. Excessive blocking by changing lanes when being lapped

3.5. Illegal contact may be reported by any participant of the meeting

3.6. Cars may be requested to pit for attention under the following circumstances: -

3.6.1. Any functional or mechanical part of the car has become completely detached from the car

3.6.2. A wing or spoiler becomes broken, completely detached from the body, or it is clear to the official at race control that when viewing the car from their normal position, that it is damaged

3.6.3. The required number of headlights/taillights are not working

3.6.4. A car is otherwise causing a hazard that may damage the circuit or other cars on the circuit

3.7. If any session is paused (red flagged), the following restrictions apply: -

3.7.1. Cars must not be removed from the track, where they have come to stop

3.7.2. Any car in the pit at the time of the red flag must have no further work completed on it until the session is resumed

3.7.3. Drivers may leave their station only under the direction of race control

3.8. During Parc Ferme conditions, cars may only be worked on under the supervision of an official

3.9. Slow or malfunctioning cars should move to the inside lane (or lane nearest to the pit) and pit as soon as possible. Race control should be notified that there is a slow car on circuit so other drivers may be warned



Circuit History

The **24 Hours of Daytona**, also known as the Rolex 24 At Daytona for sponsorship reasons, is a 24-hour sports car endurance race held annually at Daytona International Speedway in Daytona Beach, Florida. It is run on the Sports Car Course layout, a 3.56-mile (5.73 km) combined road course, utilizing portions of the tri-oval and an infield road course. Since its inception, it has been held on the last weekend of January or first weekend of February as part of Speedweeks, and it is the first major automobile race of the year in North America. The race is sanctioned by IMSA and is the first race of the season for the IMSA SportsCar Championship.

The race has had several sponsors names over the years. Since 1992, the Rolex Watch Company is the title sponsor of the race under a naming rights arrangement, replacing Sunbank (now SunTrust) which in turn replaced Pepsi in 1984. Winning drivers of all classes receive a Rolex Daytona watch.


The race has been known historically as a leg of the informal Triple Crown of endurance racing.
