










# Editor

## Lewis kicks off the weekend with a win!

**Lewis Blacker** was the first racer up to speed on the all new Le Mans circuit! After setting the most and fastest lap(s) in the three 5-minute test runs everyone had earlier in the Evening he carried that performance through to our first ever Friday night 15-minute Race. He soon put out of his mind the fact that he had crashed his Ferrari into the boonies in Qualifying, sharing  $17^{th}$  with three others. Being the first race at Le Mans Lewis set the laps track record at an initial 76.8 laps, 0.7 laps ahead of Pole sitter, for the  $18^{th}$  time (17 - 2023) and Champion elect, **Simon Goodlip**. Lewis also set the second quickest lap during the race so took home 44 points out of a maximum 45 on the way to his second career victory.

Martin Thorpe clearly liked Le Mans as he made it two Group B racers on the Podium just a lap behind Simon, while Phil Rees kept the 'B' flavour going taking fourth a further 0.9 laps back.



Gary Skipp, a fan of all things Le Mans, made his intentions for the weekend known by taking his first career fastest lap, which in turn would be his first Pole at the next race as his lap time of 10.020 beat Simon's 10.041 in the one lap Qualifying. The best of the last two lap times is awarded Pole in the next Club Night. Gary's previous best had been the second quickest lap on 13Jun23. Jag Kalyan in his only race of the weekend, as he had to work the next day, took a remarkable sixth with the seventh fastest lap, beating his previous PB of eighth way back on 17Jan23. That was now 4-2 in favour of Group B in the top six!

Steve White and Geoff Peach then squared up the tie 4-4, Steve a mere 0.1 laps back, Geoff a further 0.2 as Group A and B continue to mix it up in 2023. With the top eight all in the 70+ lap range the next nine racers recorded between 60 and 70 laps. Leading those was Group C winner Richard Booth who recorded the equal most Group points of the Round (10) finishing on 67.7 laps. Fellow Group C racer Dave Edwards followed Richard home 0.4 laps in arrears, as he rounded out the top ten. Half a lap back from Dave was our third straight Group C racer Daniel Kalyan in 11<sup>th</sup>, using up the last available power in his Audi's motor before a new one was fitted for Saturday.

Our newest Member Victor de Oliveira started his DHORC Carrera Digital campaign in Group D and promptly went and took his first Group win, in 12<sup>th</sup> overall, another half a lap back. He would tie with Richard on 10 Group points, the most of the Round. JT Hughes-Dowd, also running in his only Club Night of the weekend was a lap behind Victor, however he set the 11<sup>th</sup> fastest lap of the Race breaking his previous best of 12<sup>th</sup> set ten days earlier at Daytona! Liam Smith had taken seventh in Qualifying, beating his eighth on 19Sep23. He would almost catch JT at the end of the 15-minutes, just 0.1 laps the deficit.

Max Farnsworth was another to only run on Friday night. In his fourth ever start he broke all three PBs. Tenth in Qualifying was no less than an 11 place improvement, finishing 15<sup>th</sup> a three place betterment and the 19<sup>th</sup> fastest lap being three places better than he managed at Daytona. Stuart Gray, fresh from building the track earlier, shared 16<sup>th</sup> with fellow track builder Nick Sismey as the latter ran new rear tyres for the first time in 23 Evenings! They were both a lap behind Max.

**Laura Edwards** was the first of three racers in the 50+ lap band as she took 18<sup>th</sup> ahead of our fourth track builder **Dan Hughes-Dowd**, again in his only Race of the weekend. He did however manage to set the 14<sup>th</sup> fastest lap of the Club Night, beating his previous best of 16<sup>th</sup> way back on 06Dec22. **Macaully Dutson** had a car and motor change during the Race but still managed 51.7 laps as he brought up the rear in 20<sup>th</sup> place.

## Simon's 14th win takes him closer to the Championship!

**Simon Goodlip** edged ever closer to his first Carrera Digital Championship with his 14<sup>th</sup> victory of the year, setting a new race laps record in the process. He added 1.4 laps to Friday's winner Lewis Blacker's score. Lewis dropped to fourth on Saturday morning's first Club Night. While Simon added to his already healthy number of fastest laps in 2023 with his 14<sup>th</sup> **Gary Skipp** was celebrating his first Pole one Club Night after taking his first fastest lap. Simon's lap time was the first sub 10 second lap, which would guarantee him Pole at the next Club Night. Gary's second place finish was the start of an incredible run for Mr Skipp over the remaining four Club Nights.

Just 0.7 laps behind Gary was Martin Thorpe, who repeated his Round 36 placing of third on the Podium, with 1.1 laps more than he covered in the previous Round. He would also take the Group B win as he tried to reduce Phil Rees' lead in the Group Challenge. It was becoming clear that the Le Mans track was a track favoured by those who could maintain an excellent balance throughout the lap with there being very few big braking zones.

With four racers from Friday night not taking part today and two who didn't race yesterday running today we were up to 18 racers for the next two Club Nights. This meant a shake-up of the Groups.

Phil Rees was but 0.1 laps short of his Round 36 score however this took him down one place to fifth on a track he enjoyed and with a car he finally felt comfortable with. At his first race on the Le Mans circuit **Dean Garbett** showed he could soon learn a new track as he was only 0.4 laps in arrears of Phil. **Nick Sismey** had a much better run thanks to Simon overhauling his Porsche overnight. Where it had felt like an uncontrollable dodgem it now stuck to its intended route. It was now down to Nick to drive it properly. He took seventh, 0.4 laps behind Dean.



Steve White made it three straight Group A racers in a row, after the three Group B racers, exactly a lap behind Nick, while Geoff Peach, now running in Group B, with Dean back on the scene, marking the halfway point of the field in ninth. With the new motor in Daniel Kalyan's Audi he couldn't help but smile, his car was rapid! Having qualified a career best ninth (beating his tenth on 07Mar23), his tenth placed finish was one better than his previous best on 01Aug23. Daniel was a top ten finisher! How good did that sound, especially as he also won Group C.

**Liam Smith** shared second in Group C with **Dave Edwards**, both finishing in 11<sup>th</sup> on 66.4 laps. A one place drop for Dave but a three place gain for Liam. **Richard Booth** took 13<sup>th</sup> this time just 0.2 laps ahead of brother-in-law **Stuart Gray** who made a two place improvement compared to the Friday night Race with 14<sup>th</sup>.

Laura Edwards started her move back up the leader board with a three place improvement to 15<sup>th</sup>. This left three places in the finishing order in our smallest grid since 21Jun22. Macaully Dutson in 16<sup>th</sup> set the 10<sup>th</sup> fastest lap, beating his previous best of 11<sup>th</sup> on, you guessed it, 21Jun22. In his first race on Le Mans Simon Rankin took 17<sup>th</sup> as he learnt the track. ## **Gary & Simon share a win for the first time!**

**Simon Goodlip** and **Gary Skipp** became the first racers to share a win since DHORC began Carrera Digital racing. We have had two people in both second and third (even three in third at one time) but never have two racers shared the top step of the Podium. Their joint 78.8 laps added 0.2 laps to Simon's 15-minute race track record from the previous Round. Simon also took his 18<sup>th</sup> Pole of the year as the Championship continues to beckon. This was Gary's second career win, Simon's 16<sup>th</sup> (15<sup>th</sup> this year) as neither could be separated at the flag.

Geoff Peach increased his Round 37 score by 2.9 laps to move up from ninth to seventh here while Nick Sismey dropped 1.3 laps and a place to finish ninth. Steve White was the only other racer apart from Dean, Simon and Gary to record a sub 10 second lap. While he would finish ninth, 0.2 laps behind Nick, the extra two points he received for the fourth fastest lap took him up to seventh in points. Liam Smith was moving in the right direction at Le Mans, 14<sup>th</sup>, then 11<sup>th</sup> now 10<sup>th</sup> as he increased his lap score by 5.8 laps over the three Club Nights run to date. He also took the Group C win for the first time over the weekend. That made three different Group C winners in three Races. He would lead home a trio of 'C' racers.

Dave Edwards was enjoying himself at Le Mans as, like the previous two Rounds, he beat wifee, Laura here. Therefore for once he had the upper hand and at least wasn't going home a beaten man for once! He was 0.9 laps behind Liam but only 0.2 laps ahead of the ever smiling Daniel Kalyan in twelfth, who loved the new motor in his Audi. He again added to his best lap score, with 69.9 laps this time. Surely 70 were on the cards for Round 39!

After taking the Group D win first time out on Friday night, Victor de Oliveira took his second consecutive fifth spot in Group B here as he fought with his Ferrari's handling. While he beat Round 36's lap score by 2.4 laps he would drop from 12<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> overall in a much more competitive Group. Stuart Gray was also improving on his lap score throughout the weekend, and while he jumped from 16<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> between the first two Races he stayed in 14<sup>th</sup> this time beating Macaully Dutson by 0.2 laps. However the good news for Stuart was that he won Group D taking the equal second best number of Group points for Round 38, 7.0 points. Macaully meanwhile was taking big strides in lap scores, from 51.7 in Round 36, 60.3 in the last Round and 67.0 here, a 15.3 lap improvement! He would be winning by Round 41 at this rate!

Richard Booth was the third straight Group D racer, 0.1 laps behind Macaully and 0.3 laps behind his brother-in-law. Rather a tight Group! Laura Edwards' time would come later in the weekend at Le Mans, however this time she would take 17<sup>th</sup> 1.1 laps ahead of Simon Rankin who also improved on his lot by 1.5 laps!

Gary Skipp backed up his win in Round 38 by repeating the feat in Round 39. Despite raising the bar to 79.1 laps he wasn't totally overjoyed as he knew there were 80+ laps in the track. Still, back-to-back wins should be celebrated. And it was a clear win this time, at that, as he was 2.4 laps ahead of Poleman Dean Garbett who recorded his best result at Le Mans to date with second. Martin Thorpe was back in third place again for the third time in tfour Club Nights, just 0.1 laps behind Dean. He would again notch up 7.0 Group points for taking the 'B' for the third time at Le Sarthe.

While it was Gary's third win of the year and Dean's fifth Pole, **Simon Goodlip** took an unprecedented (in 2023) 15<sup>th</sup> fastest lap with yet another quicker lap than recorded in the last three Races. With two more Club Nights to go would that drop further?

After a fourth and two fifths with a 74.2 lap finish and two 74.1 lap finishes **Phil Rees** found himself in eighth after the fourth Race of the weekend with 72.7 laps in the books this time. He only just fended off a jubilant **Daniel Kalyan** who beat his PB of a tenth placed finish in Round 37 with a ninth here, just 0.1 laps from taking eighth and 0.4 laps from seventh! What a result!



Round 36 winner Lewis Blacker closed out his fourth Race at Le Mans down in tenth this time as he attempted to re find his performance levels of Friday night. Macaully Dutson's performance level reached their highest yet with a four place improvement in his best ever finish with eleventh! Things were looking rosy with his first Group win in 23 Races. He was the fourth different Group D winner at Le Mans. Just 0.3 laps behind Macaully was Geoff Peach scoring less than 70 laps for the first time during the weekend.

Richard Booth on the other hand recorded his best score so far at Le Mans with 68.7 laps in D2 and 13<sup>th</sup> while Dave Edwards was in C2 and 14<sup>th</sup> 1.7 laps further back. Round 38 Group D winner Stuart Gray was in D3 this time giving him 15<sup>th</sup> with Liam Smith in C3 in 16<sup>th</sup>.

Terry Mullen became our first ever Non Member to run in a Carrera Digital race as he upped the grid to 19 racers. Arriving back from holiday in the early hours of Saturday he joined us during our 30-minute lunch break, where we gave him his first experience of driving a digital slot car. He then joined Group D for the remaining three Rounds of the day. With a score of 62.1 laps he would take 17th in his first Race.

Laura Edwards may have not bothered the placings too much in this Race, with 18<sup>th</sup>, however her lap time was certainly something to write home about. Her previous best had been 11<sup>th</sup> way back on 21Jun22 at DHORC-CD 17. Here she smashed that by taking the sixth fastest lap of the Round, a fantastic result. ## **Gary breaks 80 lap barrier with hattrick!**

Gary Skipp finally did what he said he could do and became the first racer to break the 80 lap barrier at Le Mans. His 80.4 laps beat his previous track record of 79.1 laps as he became the dominant force at La Sarthe. From third on the grid he fought out the Podium places with Dean Garbett and Simon Goodlip with Round 36 winner Lewis Blacker also in the picture. Both Dean and Simon broke their own PBs trying to chase down Gary who crashed but twice in the whole of the 15 minutes! They would finish on 79.9 and 78.7 laps respectively with Lewis close behind on 78.7 laps, taking his second Group B win of the night.

Simon took both his 19<sup>th</sup> (20) Pole and 16<sup>th</sup> (18) fastest lap of the year as the Championship is almost a closed book for him, his nearest rival sitting in Vienna. Dean was also securing third place in the Championship with yet another Podium place finish. Simon's 9.456 second lap would become the fastest ever lap around the Le Mans track at the end of the Evening.

## **Gary equals record of 4 consecutive wins!**



Up until his Le Mans escapade Gary had only taken one win, at Road Atlanta on 13Jun23, now he is a five time winner, fourth equal in the all-time charts. He again set a new Le Mans 15-minute Race record with 80.8 laps, adding 0.4 laps to his previous record.



# Rules & Regulations

### 1.0 Evenings

Two Evenings run on the same circuit, seven Race and two Sprint circuits in 2023.

### 1.1 Race Groups

Up to a maximum of four Race Groups of six racers based on Ranking (last 9 Races) with the top six ranked racers in Group A, then Group B, Group C and Group D. If there are less than 24 racers on an Evening then the Race Groups will be adjusted accordingly as equally as possible. **Stop Press:** We are looking at running earlier Races, from around 17:00 hours, for Reserve racers, if there are over 24 racers, as a trial. Reserve racers have advised they can arrive earlier.

### 1.2 Qualifying

One crash and burn lap at the end of that track's Test Night for the 1<sup>st</sup> Round at any track. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round on each circuit the fastest lap from either Qualifying above or the 1<sup>st</sup> Round. Thereafter the fastest lap from the last two Rounds for any subsequent Rounds.

This also reads across to Sprint Races on a shorter version of that circuit if that circuit is chosen to hold Sprint Races.

### 1.3 Race

15-minutes with a maximum of six cars per Race Group, with a minimum of three Races for all competitors on the night (Depending on the number of competitors) Anyone can win overall from any Race Group, the winner recording the most laps plus tenths. If more than one racer finishes on the same lap and tenth in any position it will be deemed a draw.

Races begin at 18:00 hours, racers to advise if they can't make it or will be late. We will do our best to ensure all racers run in all Races.

### 1.4 Race Points

Points awarded down to 24<sup>th</sup> (possibly 27<sup>th</sup>) place for each Race with additional points awarded for the top five fastest laps. 75% of the Club Nights run will count towards the Championship so if a racer competes in all Club Nights their best 75% of points will count.



### 3.0 Driving & Racing Standards (Based on The Digital Slot Car Association Rules)

- 3.1. Any car on the circuit must be compliant with the GT rules.
- 3.2. Any indiscretion against stated regulations will be punishable by penalty (to be agreed).
- 3.3. When lapping a slower car, it is the responsibility of the faster car to change lanes and perform an overtake. Lapped cars should remain in their current lane until the faster car has passed.
  - 3.3.1. Intentionally blocking of a faster car when lapping is illegal
  - 3.3.2. Intentionally blocking a car fighting for position on the same lap is allowed
- 3.4. Contact from cars racing on the same lane, in proximity, is to be expected. Intentional or excessive contact is not allowed. Penalties (to be agreed) will be issued in the following circumstances: -
  - 3.4.1. Intentional or excessive contact with another car
  - 3.4.2. De-slotting another car by driving into the back of it
  - 3.4.3. Intentionally stopping on the circuit
  - 3.4.4. Excessive blocking by changing lanes when being lapped
- 3.5. Illegal contact may be reported by any participant of the meeting
- 3.6. Cars may be requested to pit for attention under the following circumstances: -
  - 3.6.1. Any functional or mechanical part of the car has become completely detached from the car
  - 3.6.2. A wing or spoiler becomes broken, completely detached from the body, or it is clear to the official at race control that when viewing the car from their normal position, that it is damaged
  - 3.6.3. The required number of headlights/taillights are not working
  - 3.6.4. A car is otherwise causing a hazard that may damage the circuit or other cars on the circuit
- 3.7. If any session is paused (red flagged), the following restrictions apply: -
  - 3.7.1. Cars must not be removed from the track, where they have come to stop
  - 3.7.2. Any car in the pit at the time of the red flag must have no further work completed on it until the session is resumed
  - 3.7.3. Drivers may leave their station only under the direction of race control
- 3.8. During Parc Ferme conditions, cars may only be worked on under the supervision of an official
- 3.9. Slow or malfunctioning cars should move to the inside lane (or lane nearest to the pit) and pit as soon as possible. Race control should be notified that there is a slow car on circuit so other drivers may be warned







# **Circuit History**

The **24 Hours of Daytona**, also known as the Rolex 24 At Daytona for sponsorship reasons, is a 24-hour sports car endurance race held annually at Daytona International Speedway in Daytona Beach, Florida. It is run on the Sports Car Course layout, a 3.56-mile (5.73 km) combined road course, utilizing portions of the tri-oval and an infield road course. Since its inception, it has been held on the last weekend of January or first weekend of February as part of Speedweeks, and it is the first major automobile race of the year in North America. The race is sanctioned by IMSA and is the first race of the season for the IMSA SportsCar Championship.

The race has had several sponsors names over the years. Since 1992, the Rolex Watch Company is the title sponsor of the race under a naming rights arrangement, replacing Sunbank (now SunTrust) which in turn replaced Pepsi in 1984. Winning drivers of all classes receive a Rolex Daytona watch.


The race has been known historically as a leg of the informal Triple Crown of endurance racing.



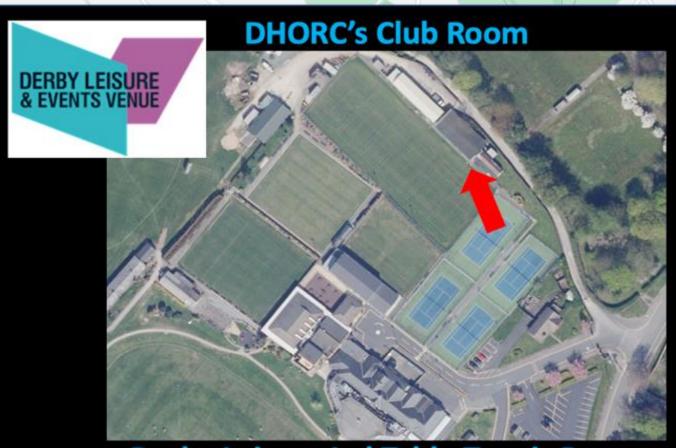
