



#### 2. All change in Qualifying for the rest of 2022

The return to the Long Beach track for the second time this year meant it was all change in Qualifying. F1 had qualified on Yellow and Red lanes so far this season, now they were on Green and Blue. None of the F1 Adult records went on Tuesday night but two of the three GC records went with **Lee Pateman** adding no less than 7.2 laps to the Qualifying record and 1.6 to the race laps record. He was also just 0.01 seconds off the fastest lap. He holds all of the GC records.



#### 3. Juniors joining Adults for Finals

Following Lewis Bowles' request to run in the Adult Finals, during the summer holidays, we had a thought, "Why don't we invite all of the Juniors who stay for the Adult Finals to join the Adult field?" Speaking to both Steve Smith and Russell Lawson, they said both Harry and Jacob are up for it, which would give them some extra experience and extra laps

The way we will run it is that they, and any other Junior who wants to join in, will qualify just the once and their laps would give them both their Junior and Adult grid position. That would ensure we don't effectively add more racers to Qualifying. Looking forward to seeing how they get on.







#### F1 Finals ADULT REPORT F1 Finals

#### Sismey takes first win since Jan'20

'A' Final – Nick Sismey took his first win on Tuesday night since 07Jan20. While he had a good car and recorded the most race laps (also his first since that Jan'20 race) on Green, for the 90<sup>th</sup> time, in Qualifying, it was **Lee Pateman** who set the pace in Qualifying taking his record 120<sup>th</sup> Pole. And truth be told Lee should have been the one to beat in the 'A'. Unfortunately a marshalling misdemeanour at the sharp left Toyota bend early in the race left him struggling to catch the field.

Nick's 85<sup>th</sup> win (only second to Lee's 113 victories) was by no means a cake walk as **Phil Rees** was on the prowl. While the former had a comfortable lead for most of the race, due to others crashing it would be Nick throwing it into the boonies near the end as Phil got his car under control. Those last three laps were incredible, Phil only lapping 0.05 seconds quicker than Nick, but the pressure was all on the leader as Phil closed him down. The relief on Nick's face at the flag was clear to see as he won by a mere 18" (see Page 20); what a race!

**Chris Bowles** was at his best at Long Beach, winning the 'B' Final by 0.4 laps from four time Champion **Simon Goodlip** and then making the most of Lee's misfortune to take third place, his second third place finish of the year. Lee did well to finish only two short (79 feet) laps behind Chris to be honest. Although his fastest lap of the night (his record 275<sup>th</sup>), at 5.64 seconds, helped, which was 0.41 seconds quicker than anyone else in the 'A'. So close were the top three that the difference in their fastest laps was only 0.06 seconds! The good news for Lee was that he still extended his Championship lead!

'B' Final — Having won the 'C' Final and taken second here in the 'B' Simon equalled the Final points record at Long Beach of 3.5 points, joining Lewis Blacker, John Lamb and Adam Turnbull in the record books. Just 0.4 laps more and he would have broken that points record. Adam and Simon's fastest laps in the 'B' were only separated by 0.07 seconds so close were they to each other, with 0.2 laps, the run down to the hairpin, separating their cars, as the power ebbed away, in Simon's favour. Adam still retains the lead in the DHORC Final Challenge but by a decreasing margin. Angus Smith had a quiet evening for his standards, the tight track not suiting his driving style. He would take a lonely seventh overall, 1.9 laps behind his contemporaries.

C' Final – Prior to the two very close Finals the 'C' was a much more relaxed affair with everyone not really bothering each other! Simon's win was by 2.9 laps over our now number 1 Race Controller **Dan Turnbull**. He in turn was 3.7 laps ahead of Lewis, however Master Blacker's 3.0 Final points places him within 2.0 points of the DHORC Final Challenge leader Adam. **Dean Garbett** needs a new approach as he has always been a top fiver in F1. Again he qualified low, for him, in 8<sup>th</sup> but then worse was to come with car problems ending his race after just 8.5 laps. Being the second fastest in the race he should have at least challenged for the win. We are sure Dean will soon get it together and be shooting for the podium again.

**'D' Final** – **Stuart Gray** and **Macaully Dutson** lapped quicker than Lewis in the 'D', in Stuart's case much quicker, like 0.79 seconds a lap quicker but it was Lewis who kept it on the island more to reach the 'C'. Macaully thought he had a car problem in Qualifying as it was so slow, but it turned out to be a hand controller issue. Here he had a great tussle with Stuart for 11<sup>th</sup>, the latter finishing just 0.5 laps ahead. It was a night of improvements though for Macaully. His 11<sup>th</sup> on the grid was five places better than his previous best, 12<sup>th</sup> finishing place two better as was his 13<sup>th</sup> fastest lap. His 12<sup>th</sup> in race laps was four places better: a good night in all!

**E' Final** – **Andrew Thompson** was on his lonesome in the early 'E' Final, so we put him with Junior Non Member **Korbin Campbell** for some competition. While he would take his 9<sup>th</sup> Wooden Spoon, he did set some personal bests. His 13<sup>th</sup> on the grid was one better than his 14<sup>th</sup> in February, while his 13<sup>th</sup> in the final reckoning was also one better than his previous best set way back on 22Oct13.

#### Nick, nicks 4th win by a whisker

Thanks to just keeping Phil at bay in the 'A' Nick also took his 4<sup>th</sup> Master win of the year. Championship leader Angus followed Phil home followed by Dean and Stuart.


#### **Lewis cruises to 8th win from 11th start**

'A' Final – Lewis Bowles cruised to his 8<sup>th</sup> win of the year from his 11<sup>th</sup> start, breaking the absent Jacob Lawson's fastest lap record in the process. Our Championship leader extended his lead with a perfect 50 points haul, his fifth of the year. **Jamie Thompson** jumped into second in the Championship with runner up spot here, 2.2 laps in arrears, while **Ella Doyle** secured her second straight podium finish keeping the others honest. Lewis also extended his DHORC Final Challenge lead by another 0.5 points taking it out to 3.0 points.

Friend of Lewis, **Korbin Campbell** ran as a Non Member at Long Beach and certainly wasn't overawed by the experience recording third on the grid, and in fastest lap/race laps. Hopefully he will return in the future.
