#### 4. Oval racing is back!

The Sunday before the Miami Club Night marked a month to go before we are back Oval racing at DHORC. DHORCingham, produced from the ashes of the Rockingham Motor Speedway, will be used for the first time on Tuesday 25Jul23.

The four classes will be as follows:-

1.DHORC provided brass weighted V-Jet F1 cars.


- 2.DHORC provided Bulldog GC cars.
- 3.Members own Tyco F1 cars
- 4.Members own Viper GC cars

Qualifying will be done in twos with one racer running an F1 car on the tighter Lane 6 the other the GC car on the faster Lane 4. They will run for five laps and their grid position based on their overall time for those five laps. Cars can be marshalled. Then they will swap until both have run all four cars. The Finals will then be 8-lanes and three-minutes in length, like a normal Club Night, with racers choosing lanes as usual. The winner moving up. These will be Crash & Burn so if you crash you are out. Watch out for the squeeze track in Turn 4.






# Race Report

## Round 10 Miami – GC Finals 27 June 2023



Angus Smith (right) took his third win of the year from Pole, while Lee Pateman (second left) continues to lead the Championship and set a new GC race laps record. #### GC Finals ADULT REPORT GC Finals Angus joins 2023 triple winners

**A' Final** – **Angus Smith** became the third racer to win three Club Nights in 2023 on Tuesday night following in the footsteps of Championship leader **Lee Pateman** and **Simon Goodlip**. The 100.9 laps that took Angus to his 53<sup>rd</sup> Pole was only the second 100+ lap Qualifying score at Miami, Lee holding the record with 103 laps. Angus' last win was on 21Feb23, so it was badly needed to get his Championship challenge back on track. Lee won the January F1 race at Miami from Angus by 0.7 laps, the latter taking the GC race win on Tuesday by 1.2 laps from the former.

Simon celebrated his 2,000 three-minute race start on Red Iane in Qualifying by beating Angus' fastest Iap record, reducing it from 5.53 seconds to 5.48, and only missing out on equalling Lee's Iaps record by 0.1 Iaps! He had little time to celebrate however as Lee then came along and broke both records during his run on Red. 29.7 Iaps were converted to 31.6 and Simon's 5.48 became Lee's 5.41 seconds! These were the highest race Iaps scored on the night so Lee's third straight race Iaps win added up to an unprecedented 187<sup>th</sup> over nearly 32 years of racing! Talking of big numbers Lee also recorded his 500<sup>th</sup> Individual Qualifying Round when he won Red Iane!

Back to the 'A' Final and Simon took third 2.1 laps behind Lee, however he went home happy as he wrestled Lee's new fastest lap record off him, taking it down to 5.28 seconds! **Reuben Litherland** made it into the 'A' after winning the 'B' and was immediately on the pace, lapping in 5.54 seconds, matching Lee and beating Angus by 0.05 seconds: so close! Angus' 30.8 laps in the 'A' also broke the old race laps record. What a performance by our top three racers, with Reuben close behind!







Jamie Thompson qualified 4th for the fifth time in a row and made it five consecutive Junior 'B' Final wins finishing 4<sup>th</sup>. Dad Andrew Thompson finished 20<sup>th</sup> this week.

**B' Final** – **Chris Bowles** beat Reuben to first lane choice in the 'B' by just 0.2 laps after 12 minutes of Qualifying. Reuben reversed these placings in the Final taking the the win 28.0 laps to 27.6, with their best lap times in favour of Chris by a mere 0.03 seconds! **Adam Turnbull** and 'C' Final winner **Nick Sismey** couldn't stay with these two on Blue and Yellow lanes respectively. Adam beat Nick to sixth by 0.9 laps.

**'C' Final** – **Phil Rees'** pink GC car certainly had pace down the straights if not quite the handling it needed through the curves. Nick lead the attack against Phil's car but like **Lewis Blacker** and 'D' Final winner **Geoff Peach**, as soon as their cars got close to Phil's they hit the boonies in an effort to catch him. By half distance it seemed like Phil just had to continue doing what he was doing and the others would just run out of breath and ability. Nick however finally caught him, but struggled to stay ahead until Phil made his first mistake. That was just enough for his mate to build up a lead for the first time, which eventually extended out to 1.1 laps. All were exhausted!

**Lewis Blacker** was a further 0.9 laps back in his 301<sup>st</sup> race, with Geoff only 0.4 laps up the road. This was Lewis' third 9<sup>th</sup> place finish in a row while Geoff's 2.5 points total meant he joined Lewis atop the DHORC Challenge table, up from fourth after the previous Club Night.

**D' Final** – **Dan Turnbull** took a break from running 27 straight three-minute races at Race Control to Qualify in 11<sup>th</sup> directly behind Geoff, 0.8 laps separating the two. In the 'D' Dan was favourite initially as Geoff had a big off leaving him well behind the eight ball. The new calmer Geoff consolidated however and slowly passed his fellow Finalists. First 'E' Final winner **Russell Lawson**, who had won his first Final of the year, and then **JJ Hughes-Dowd** before moving past Dan and adding a further 1.4 laps to Dan's score at the flag.

Russell unfortunately had car problems after 11.6 laps finishing in 16<sup>th</sup>, while JJ was three laps behind Dan, although he did beat his Junior 'A' lap score by 0.5 laps.

**E' Final** – **Dan Hughes-Dowd's** 1.5 Final points in the 'E' for taking second place and 14<sup>th</sup> overall took him to within 0.5 points of the lead of the DHORC Challenge. Dan was only 0.3 laps behind Russell, with a borrowed rear axle from Simon, running Shloke Anand's (See Page 15) old Indian flag coloured Porsche 917. In a very close fought Final top 'E' Final qualifier **Stuart Gray** was only just over a lap behind Dan while 'F' Final winner **Jacob Lawson** would have taken second behind his dad with his previous Final score. However Yellow lane reduced his attack by four laps taking 4<sup>th</sup> in his second Final (which would be a theme in every Final throughout the evening) in 16<sup>th</sup>.

**F' Final** – **Denis Latham,** in only his sixth race start, set the 14<sup>th</sup> fastest lap of the night, beating his previous best of 15<sup>th</sup> on 21Feb23. Despite Dan Qualifying three places above Jacob and lapping 0.35 seconds quicker it was 13-year old Jacob who used his experience from 85 starts to win the 'F' by 2.4 laps.

**'Early G' Final.** – Alan Stevenson again took home the Early Final, the Final of three A's, with Andrew Woodhouse a lap further back and Andrew Thompson taking home his fourth Wooden Spoon. As covered on Page 15 James MacKinlay ran as a Non-Member but only Qualified.

#### Lewis closes in on JJ's Championship lead!

Missing Round 9 has put him on the back foot, however he will get that Round back later in the year. JJ meanwhile had a pretty good evening finishing second to his mate, 1.7 laps the margin. Added to this JJ took his first back to back Pole position and broke Lewis' F1 fastest lap record, set in January, taking it down from 8.62 seconds to 8.26. 

# **Circuit History**

The Autódromo José Carlos Pace, better known as **Interlagos**, is a 4.309 km (2.677 mi) motorsport circuit located in the city of São Paulo, in the neighbourhood of Interlagos. It was inaugurated on 12 May 1940, by the federal intervener Adhemar de Barros. The traditional name of the circuit and of the neighbourhood itself comes from the fact that it is located in a region between two large artificial lakes, Guarapiranga and Billings, which were built in the beginning of the 20th century to supply the city with water and electricity. In 1985 the circuit was renamed to honour the Formula 1 driver José Carlos Pace, who died in a plane crash in 1977. Attached to its facilities there is a Kart circuit named after Ayrton Senna. The circuit runs counter clockwise.

It is internationally known for hosting the Formula 1 Brazilian Grand Prix and the Lollapalooza music festival. It has hosted the Formula One Brazilian Grand Prix since 1973. It also hosted the Brazilian motorcycle Grand Prix in 1992, the Deutsche Tourenwagen Meisterschaft in 1996, the FIA GT1 World Championship in 2010, and the FIA World Endurance Championship from 2012 to 2014. As the major racetrack in the country it also hosted many previous and active national championships such as Stock Car Brasil, Campeonato Sudamericano de GT, Fórmula Truck, Copa Truck, Formula 3 Sudamericana, Brazilian Formula Three Championship, and Mil Milhas Brasil. In addition, the Prova Ciclística 9 de Julho road cycling race was held at the venue from 2002 to 2006 and from 2008 to 2013.


One of the main characteristics of Interlagos is that it was not built on flat terrain, but follows the ups and downs of hilly ground, which makes it harder to drive and demands more power from the cars' engines. The races therefore can be tough on the car and physically demanding on the drivers, especially since the circuit runs counter clockwise, where the centrifugal forces in the many hard left turns push the drivers' necks to the right, instead of left as in most of the circuits on the F1 calendar. The hilly course is also a good feature for road cycling races, which are usually held at the circuit.

Additionally to the physical aspects there is also a climate component to the venue, the region where the track is located is known for having rapid changes in weather with outbursts of rain being common, which can vary from a short lived drizzle to a torrential storm. This can add a degree of unpredictability to the races and it's classic associated with the circuit. The city of São Paulo itself where Interlagos is located is known by the nickname "Land of the Drizzle".


