

DHORCingham – F1 (V-Jet)
25 July 2023

Steve takes 1st win at 103rd attempt!

Note: The 8-lane Group races were win overall with the most laps from any Group, to Crash and Burn rules. Which Group the racer was in was based on their 5-lap Qualifying time with **Group A** for the top qualifiers, then **Group B** and **Group C**. Juniors just **Group A**.


Steve Smith finally secured his first win at DHORC on his 103rd race start. Joining DHORC almost seven years ago to the day (26Jul16) Steve's previous best result had been 4th at DHORC 535 on 25Feb17 on the old Rockingham Oval. He set three other PBs during this, the first of four Club Nights on one evening. By winning the Group stage he also set the most laps on the night, recording his first best race laps, beating his 4th on 25Feb17. This was also his first track record! Clearly Steve loves ovals as his previous best Qualifying of 7th was also at the 25Feb17 race, which he has now reduced to 5th! Finally he also beat his 7th fastest lap on 13Dec22 (not an oval but Oulton Park) by recording 4th here.

Chris Bowles so nearly made it a first win for himself from the 'B', losing out to Steve by just 0.2 laps. He must have felt confident before the 'A' started as 40+ laps was a great score in the 'B'! He even lapped quicker than Steve with a 4.34 second lap to the latter's 4.37. Still second from ninth on the grid was a great result and it was his first Group/Final win of the year! Adam Turnbull secured his second career Pole (last one on 22Feb22), by a mere 0.02 seconds, ahead of Championship leader Simon Goodlip. Adam would take third overall, 2.8 laps behind Chris and 14.1 laps ahead of Simon.





Adult Group C – JJ Hughes-Dowd & Nick Sismey both 10th with Macaully Dutson sharing 15th with two others.



Dan Turnbull was one of four racers who set exactly the same Qualifying time in fifth. Steve and **Angus Smith**, also in fifth on the grid, even set the same lap time as well! We had to give Angus lane choice as he set the time first. Dan was only separated from **Lee Pateman**, the other racer in fifth, by 0.01 seconds on fastest lap as well! With Steve taking victory Dan was second best of this quartet, taking fifth at the flag 5.7 laps behind Simon.

Liam Smith, finishing in sixth, was the last racer out of 20 to record a double lap score from 13th on the grid. His 11.2 laps saw him 6.9 laps behind Dan but two laps up on **Stuart Gray**, another to improve on his Qualifying performance of 16th, moving up nine places as the power ebbed away.

Harry Smith and Lewis Blacker shared eighth, both on 4.9 laps, but both again moving up the grid, Lewis four places, Harry seven! JJ Hughes-Dowd was certainly on the edge during his 2.2 laps as he set his first ever fastest lap on a Club Night. Surely it must have been set on his only flying lap as the first lap would have been from a standing start! His previous best had been 6th a week earlier at Interlagos. A strange race for JJ as he qualified 20th and last (just 1.04 seconds covered the grid – the closest on the night), set the fastest ever V-Jet lap at DHORCingham and finished equal 10th with Nick Sismey!

JJ's dad **Dan Hughes-Dowd** was next up and "something you don't hear said very often" shared 12th with double reigning Champion Angus, both hitting the barriers after just 1.7 laps. They had only been separated in Qualifying by 0.19 seconds, Dan in 4th (beating his previous PB of 10th on 03May23) and Angus 5th.

Andrew Woodhouse ran on one of the two lanes available in the Junior Group (we should have put **Russell Lawson** in the other as he also had to go early), but he should have run in Adult Group B. He was one of six racers to not make a lap, crashing halfway round the 107'11" DHORCingham Oval to take 14th.

Macaully Dutson, Lee and Phil Rees were a trio of drivers in 15th place only notching up 0.3 laps as cars came together. It was certainly a shame for Phil as he had qualified in third, with Lee in 5th, as mentioned above. Macaully improved on his lot however from 19th on the grid.

Dennis Latham was 10th equal in Qualifying but set the fastest lap in the session, taking home an extra point for his efforts. He wouldn't improve on this in the Group stage however as he only made the first corner alongside **Lewis Bowles**, both finishing in 18th. However his lap time in Qualifying was good enough for 6th overall, beating his previous best of 14th on 27Ju23. His 10th place in Qualifying was also two places better than his previous PB of 12th on 21Feb23.

As we unfortunately didn't realise quickly enough that Russell should also have run with the Juniors alongside Andrew he didn't run in the Group stage so took 20th overall, his first Wooden Spoon of the year!

MASTERS REPORT

Simon in 7th heaven

Simon, in fourth overall, I took his seventh Masters win of the year to extend his Championship lead. He was followed home by Stuart with his best ever Masters' finish in second, with Nick, Angus and Phil next in line.

JUNIOR REPORT

Jenson takes 2nd career victory!

Jenson Woodhouse backed up his first career victory at his first ever Club Night on 09Aug22 with a win here by a staggering 33.6 laps, as the remaining four Members only record 1.2 laps between them! On the road it was Non-Member **Isaac Lawson**, son of Russell and brother to Jacob, both Members, who recorded an excellent 20.8 laps in his first attempt! Jenson, by virtue of the win and the format we were running, also took his second career best race laps after the first on the same night of his inaugural win.

Both Lewis Bowles and JJ Hughes-Dowd took second with a very sheepish 0.4 laps, Harry Smith and Ellis Woodhouse both in fourth, with half that score! But that wasn't the whole story of five-year old Ellis' amazing evening! The Juniors Qualified after the Adults for once and when Ellis got hold of the Club V-Jet F1 it must have been perfectly run in after the previous 20 Qualifying runs and reached its sweet spot. Up until then the fastest Qualifying time had been set by Adam in the Adults at 22.72 seconds. Ellis lowered that to an impressive 20.16 seconds, 3.38 seconds quicker than the next Junior. He also set the all-time fastest lap with a 3.85 second lap, the only racer to do a sub four second lap time! This therefore gave him his first Pole and fastest lap beating his fifth best on 14Mar23 and 18Jul23 respectively. Congrats Ellis. Fourth was also his best finish.
