



# **Lee and Simon inseparable**

Note: The 8-lane Group races were win overall with the most laps from any Group, to Crash and Burn rules. Which Group the racer was in was based on their 5-lap Qualifying time with Group A for the top qualifiers, then Group B and Group C. Juniors just Group A.

**Simon Goodlip** and **Lee Pateman** were inseparable in the Bulldog race, both finishing the Group stage on 37.3 laps apiece. Simon was probably a couple of mms away from making it 37.4 laps but when you looked along the 5<sup>th</sup> tenth there was definitely some part of his car behind the tenth. These were Lee and Simon's 120<sup>th</sup> and 88<sup>th</sup> career wins to date with the latter being the first to five in 2023.

On the night we thought Stuart Gray had taken his first ever podium and the picture was taken accordingly. However when the results were checked later it was discovered that Andrew Woodhouse, running with the Juniors as he had to leave early, had in fact beaten Stuart to the podium by 0.8 laps. While it was also Andrew's first visit, 4<sup>th</sup> was still a career best finish for Stuart.

Andrew's previous PB had been 14<sup>th</sup> in his first ever Club Night on 09Aug22, while his third in race laps was five places better than his result on 18Jul23. Stuart's finish was one place better than his 5<sup>th</sup> on 09Nov21 where he also set the 7<sup>th</sup> best race laps. That was improved upon to 4<sup>th</sup> also.

Just 0.3 laps behind Stuart and 1.1 laps away from the podium was **Denis Latham** in fifth. This was a six place improvement on his 11<sup>th</sup> placed finish on 21Feb23 which in turn meant he beat his best race laps position of 12<sup>th</sup>, set on the same day, by seven places! Work colleague **Chris Bowles** was but 0.2 laps further back from Denis while Pole sitter from the previous round **Adam Turnbull** finished on the same lap as these two, half a lap further back.

Fifth down to eighth was covered by only a lap, **Angus Smith** recording the second fastest lap in the Group stage but dropping five places from third on the grid. **Dan Turnbull** improved on his 15<sup>th</sup> placed grid slot with 9<sup>th</sup> at the flag, 1.1 laps behind Angus. **Phil Rees** rounded out the top ten only a tenth behind Dan from fifth on the grid. He must have been so proud that all of his Lexan F1s and GC worked flawlessly throughout the night on a track he made happen! He also set the fastest lap of the Group stage, 0.01 seconds quicker than Angus.

There were an incredible 25.5 laps between the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> placed finishers, which saw overall (Adults and Juniors) DHORCingham Bulldog race laps record holder Lewis Bowles only taking home 3.2 laps this time, although that was still a seven place improvement on his grid slot. Liam Smith also improved on his, going from 16<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup>, half a lap down on Lewis.

Lewis' namesake **Lewis Blacker** shared a 13<sup>th</sup> place finish with **Nick Sismey**, both crashing somehow just after the finish line, on the straight (?) as they started their third lap. While Lewis had dropped from sixth on the grid and felt bad enough Nick must have been distraught! He had earlier taken his first Pole position since 07Jan20, which also gave him his 400<sup>th</sup> Individual Qualifying Round, only to throw it all away in the first 10 seconds of the Group stage. His 4.11 second lap in Qualifying was also good enough for him to take his first Club Night fastest lap for over seven years, the last on 27Feb16.

It was two father son pairings up next. Fresh from his first ever Club Night win **Steve Smith** matched son **Harry Smith** here on just 1.4 laps. Harry had pipped dad by 0.10 seconds in Qualifying to take 7<sup>th</sup> to Steve's 8<sup>th</sup> but they couldn't be separated in the Group stages. Harry's 7<sup>th</sup> on the grid was three better than his previous PB on 13Dec22. The following two were also a father son pairing, with **Dan Hughes-Dowd** and **JJ Hughes-Dowd** both taking to the boonies after just 0.4 of a lap. They did however beat one Group racer, **Macaully Dutson** who lost his car's drive 0.1 laps earlier in a frantic early Group B race. His 7<sup>th</sup> fastest lap on the night however was two better than his previous best on 27Sep22.

Again Russell Lawson unfortunately took home the Wooden Spoon.


# Simon's two out of two

# **Lewis sets overall track on way to victory!**

**Lewis Bowles** took the third overall record set by a Junior on Tuesday night with the 39.1 laps he took to victory in the GC Bulldog race, beating the Adult's best score by 1.8 laps. This was his 11<sup>th</sup> win of the 2023 season as he sets his sights on retaining his Championship from 2022.

Following victory in the first race of the evening **Jenson Woodhouse** had to settle for second here, 4.8 laps back. A score that would have beaten his dad in the Adults, who took third overall there! To add to this Jenson earlier set his first career Pole position, one place better than his previous best a week earlier. **Harry Smith** joined these two on the podium in third, 15.4 laps in arrears.

Our youngest current DHORC Member **Ellis Woodhouse** showed his DHORC 671 fastest lap was no fluke by repeating the performance here. Incredible! He would have been sixth in the Adults with that time. **JJ Hughes-Dowd** was the only Junior to not make a lap, however he did beat his Adult Group score of 0.4 laps by 0.2 laps! Non-Member **Isaac Lawson** again beat several Members and would have taken third as a Member, however he was again classified in sixth.
