


Front Cover: An F1 Tyco Group grid

Nick becomes 6th winner of '23

Note: The 8-lane Group races were win overall with the most laps from any Group, to Crash and Burn rules. Which Group the racer was in was based on their 5-lap Qualifying time with Group A for the top qualifiers, then Group B and Group C. Juniors just Group A.

Nick Sismey took his first win of the year in our third Club Night at DHORCingham to record his 86th DHORC victory from 4th on the grid. His last win had been on 28Jun22 where he also recorded his last best race laps, which he extended to 91 here. **Simon Goodlip** moved up from 10th on the grid to take second five laps back from Nick. This continued to extend his Championship lead.

Lewis Blacker took his best career result with third in his 71st Club Night and 315th race. His previous best had been 6th on 29Nov22, and with it he set the third best race laps of the round, one better than his fourth on 17May22.

Just 0.4 laps separated the next four places with **Liam Smith** taking what would be his best result of the night with 4th from 11th on the grid. **Stuart Gray** and **Dan Turnbull** converted 12th and 9th on the grid to joint 5th at the end of the Group B race running side by side in lanes seven and eight, 0.2 laps behind Liam. In the same Group, on lane three **JJ Hughes-Dowd** was another 0.2 laps back. His 7th placed finish was two better than his previous best on 29Nov22, which was matched in both cases with his 7th placed race laps.

Fellow Junior racer **Harry Smith** was 1.9 lap in arrears of JJ with **Denis Latham** the last racer to record 30+ laps in 9th. **Andrew Woodhouse** continued to record some good results, rounding out the top 10 here with a 1.3 lap deficit to Denis, Andrew running in his 12th Club Night to Denis' 11th.

Dan Hughes-Dowd was next up in 11th, his 11th best race laps one better than his 12th on 02May23. Macaully Dutson took his best result of the evening to date with 12th 1.7 laps behind Dan. He however beat notable F1 racer Phil Rees by 0.4 laps. Phil had the much quicker car but that probably brought about his race end as Macaully's car just wasn't quick enough to crash. In fact he had the slowest car of the Group stage!

Chris Bowles in contrast had the quickest car in the Group races, having taken second in Qualifying as well as setting the second fastest lap of the night. However gravity, magnetism and tyre grip weren't enough to prevent him hitting the barriers after 22.5 laps as he took 14th. **Lee Pateman** was only lapping 0.07 seconds slower but came unstuck at the same point a lap earlier!

Steve Smith's first ever win with F1 V-Jet seemed a long time ago as he set off on the third set of Group races of the night. This time it was just 8.4 laps in the bag before he joined three others already on the side lines. Joint Junior winner **Lewis Bowles** recorded 28.1 laps less than in the Junior Group A race to take joint 17th alongside F1 V-Jet pole sitter **Adam Turnbull** who had also taken 5th on the grid here.

Pole sitter and Qualifying/fastest lap track record holder **Angus Smith's** joy lasted but 0.4 laps as he dropped 18 places to 19th. A Club Night result he is sure to drop come year end. Only **Russell Lawson** not running in the Group stages prevented Angus from picking up the Wooden Spoon

Nick's overall victory also gave him the win in the Masters ahead of Championship leader Simon, Stuart (another great result), Phil and Angus.

Jenson Woodhouse and Lewis Bowles backed up their earlier wins in F1 V-Jet and GC Bulldog with joint first place here. As shown on Page 15 Jenson's car rolled passed Lewis' as the power switch was rocked to off, which in a normal Club Night Final would have meant Jenson would have won. However with it being Group races where you could win from any Group anyone on the same lap and tenth are given the same scores (as you don't know in separate Groups where cars finished compared to each other within a tenth).

Lewis took home both the Pole and fastest lap record, while they shared the race laps track record.

JJ Hughes-Dowd was only 0.8 laps further back with Harry Smith 1.4 laps in arrears to JJ in our closes Junior Group A race of the evening.

Ellis Woodhouse would go down in history as taking fifth as he was a Member however it was Non-Member Isaac Lawson who truly took this accolade 0.4 laps ahead of Ellis.








