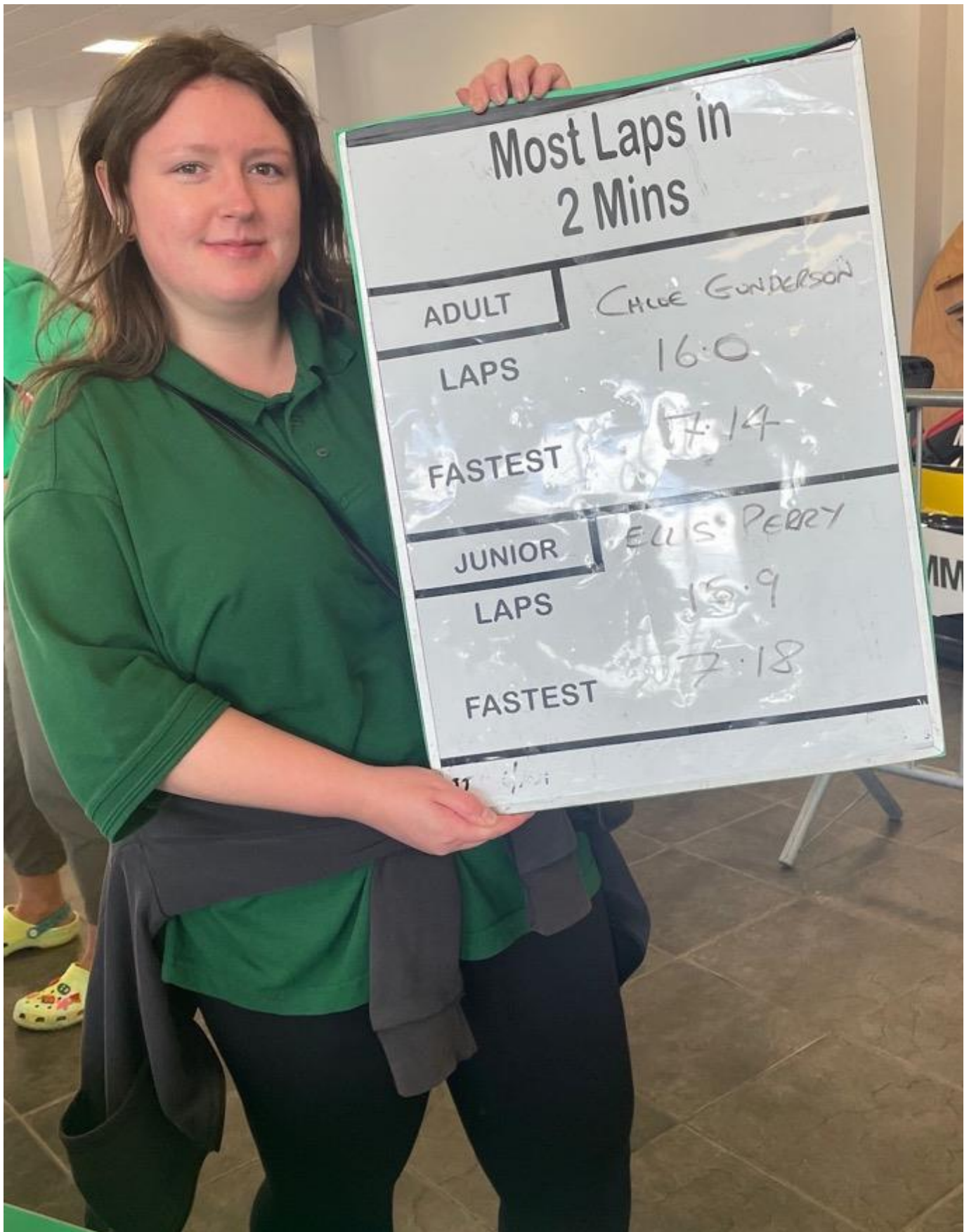

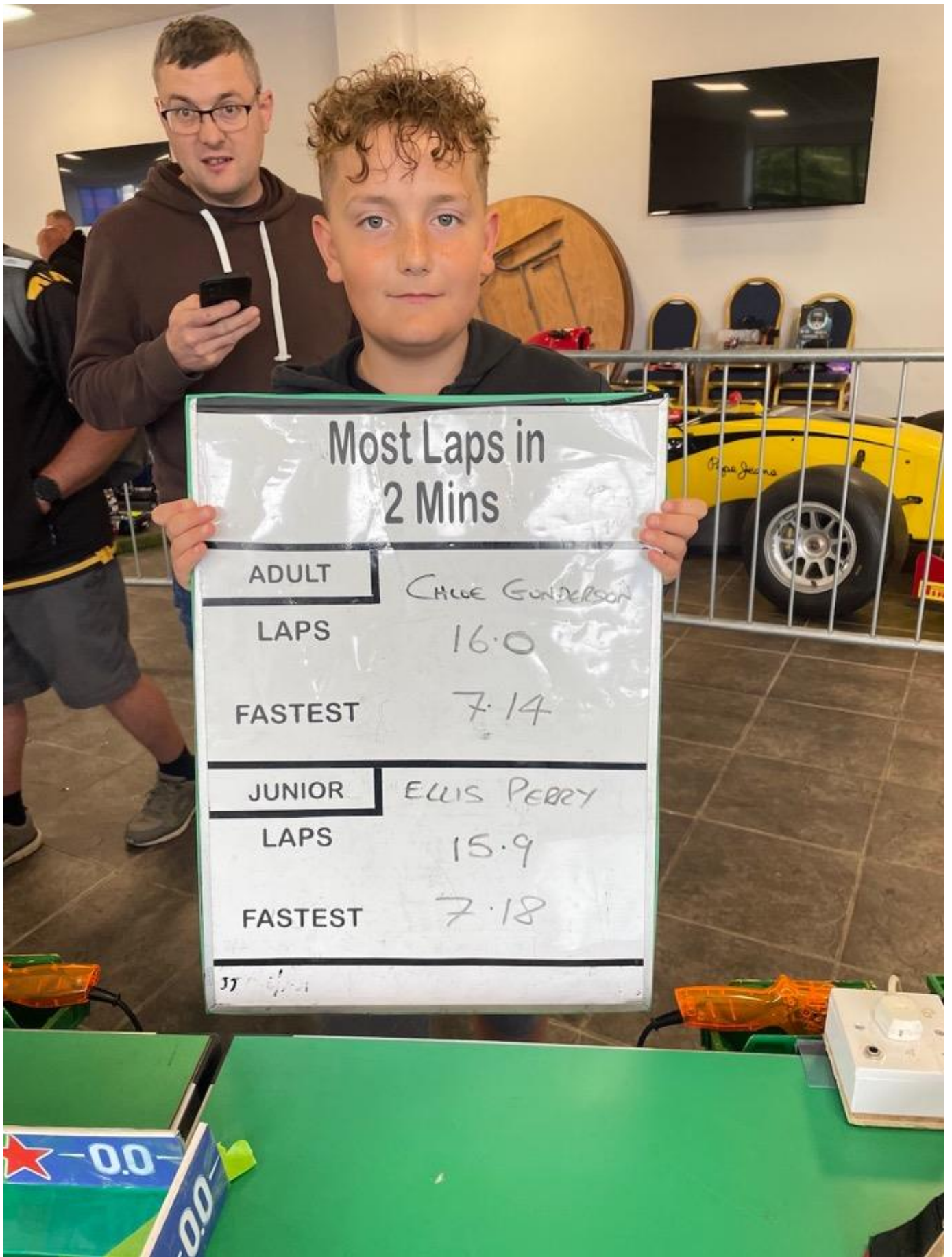

F1 Finals ADULT REPORT F1 Finals

Adam keeps his head to take victory

'A' Final – Double Junior Champion **Adam Turnbull** took his first win on Tuesday night since 27Sep22, notching up his fourth career Adult victory. And to do so he used his head as all around lost theirs. With much quicker machinery around him he wasn't expecting a great result but after the first 30 seconds of racing he found himself almost a lap up. In disbelief he set about consolidating this gift horse and proceeded to canter through the Lincolnshire countryside to the win as the others galloped after him.

Lee Pateman managed to get the closest to Adam, after winning the 'B', although he would have probably shared second or even moved into third if **Angus Smith** hadn't have crashed exactly at the same time as Lee with a couple of seconds to go. Thinking the race was over **Nick Sismey** was already celebrating Adam's win rather than continuing to marshal the mountain section, much to Angus' chagrin, who proceeded to chastise Nick for his misdemeanour. Not crashing would also have helped, but the moment was soon lost to history after apologies were made. A mere 0.1 laps separated two of our Championship challengers, 0.6 laps behind Adam.

Championship contender Lee Pateman finished best of his two compatriots with second.

Poles sitter and Championship leader **Simon Goodlip** broke two Cadwell Park F1 records on the night. He recorded 24.8 laps on Green Lane, beating Angus 24.6 laps set on 21Feb23. Then in the 'A', after changing a rear axle during the race, he smashed Lee's 6.47 second fastest lap, also recorded in February, bringing it down to 6.28 seconds. He would finish in fourth, with just too much to make up in the time, 5.2 laps down. However his five points in Qualy meant he finished only two points behind Lee and two above Angus.

'B' Final – We had a new first time 4-lane 'B' Finalists here by the name of **Denis Latham**. Having won his first ever Final, the 'C', Denis could just about make out the glimmer of an 'A' Final placing for the first time. What he hadn't expected was for Lee to match Angus old track record of 24.6 laps to take the win by 1.8 laps from **Phil Rees**. Nick's F1 was slow but just stayed on as he fell back another 0.9 laps from Phil, while Denis beat Nick on lap time but came home in seventh 3.3 laps in arrears. Welcome to the 'B' Final Denis and congrats for your first Final win.

'C' Final – **Lewis Bowles** was the best of the three Juniors also running in the Adults, but even he couldn't close the gap to Denis, despite lapping 0.30 seconds quicker. He would have needed another 0.7 laps to have equalled Denis. His 7.21 second lap was half a second quicker than anything he set in the Juniors earlier. Had he set such a lap time in the Juniors he would have smashed the track record! It was good enough for fourth fastest lap of the night beating his previous best of sixth on 18Jul23.

Behind reigning Junior Champion Lewis was former double Junior Champion and 'D' Final winner **Reuben Litherland**, now 19, who got within 0.5 of Lewis. Reuben mentioned it was sister Maisie's 18th birthday this Saturday – the last time we saw her she was winning the 10 and under Cadet Championship – time flies!

JJ Hughes-Dowd, having won the Junior 'A' Final earlier, had to settle for rounding out the top ten in the Adults 2.7 laps behind Reuben.

'D' Final – **Chris Bowles** was a surprise starter in the 'D' Final despite running the third fastest F1 car on the night. He admitted he didn't particularly like the track. He took second in the Final to Reuben but nearly three laps back on the black top. Another 1.1 laps back was **Lewis Blacker** (just so we could get the word "black" in four times on one line!) who beat our third Junior and 'E' Final winner **Harry Smith** by 1.2 laps.

'E' Final – Rockingham Oval F1 winner **Steve Smith** had the ignominy of losing to son Harry here, by 1.7 laps, however a son win is a family win so dad was proud.

'Early F' Final – **Andrew Woodhouse** had qualified an excellent eighth and had no-one to beat in the Early Final so ran in the Junior 'B', which he oddly won on the road. However that didn't save him from taking his fifth Wooden Spoon, putting him into the lead of that Championship.

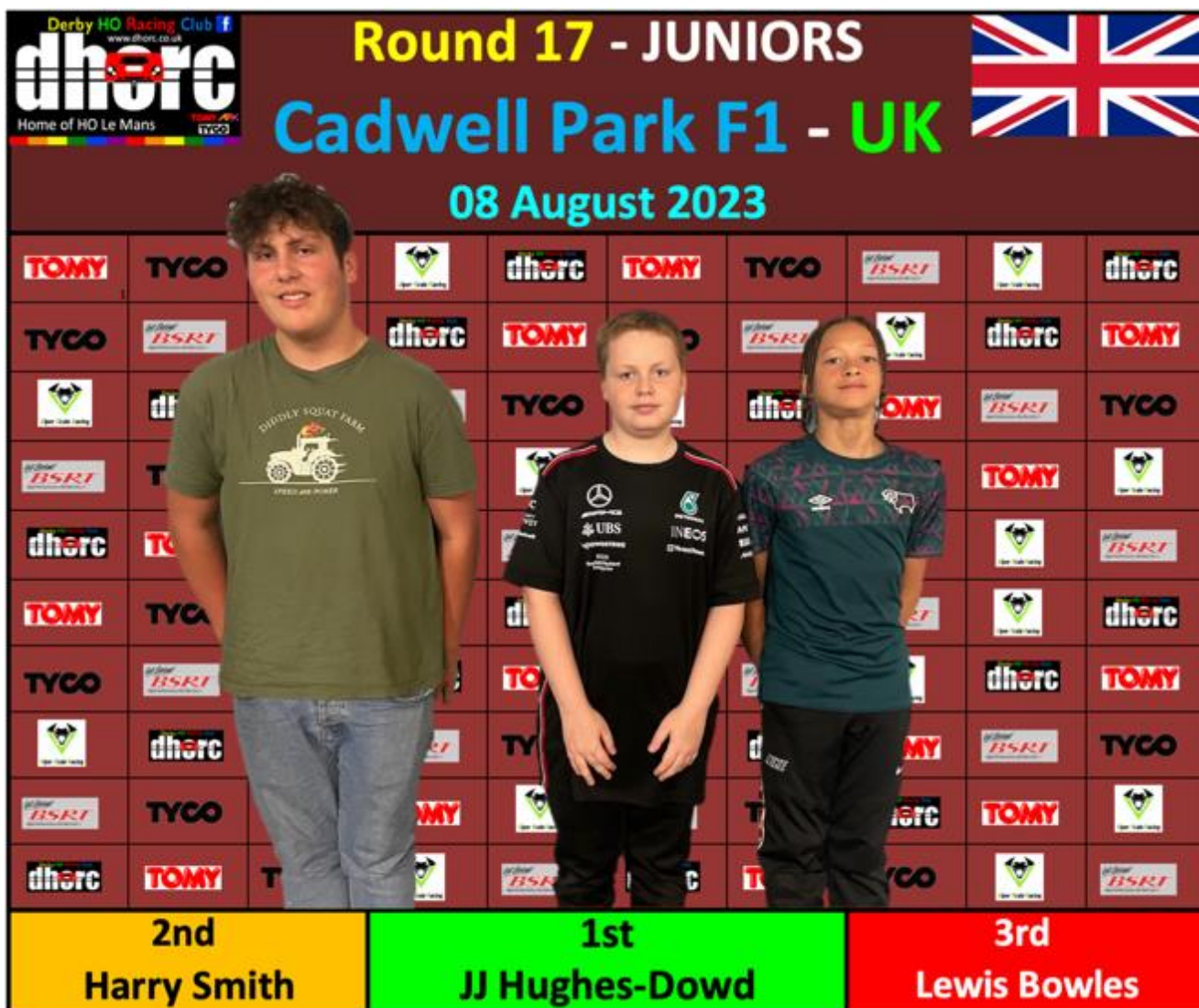

Having missed out in a top spot at the four DHORCingham Club Nights he was determined to make amends here. Having taken Pole by 1.6 laps and breaking his old Pole record set on 21Feb23 by 3.9 laps, **Lewis Bowles** looked favourite to take his 13th win of the year. However after a couple of early offs thanks to pressure from friend JJ, who also beat the old Pole record, Lewis found himself scrabbling for a podium placing.

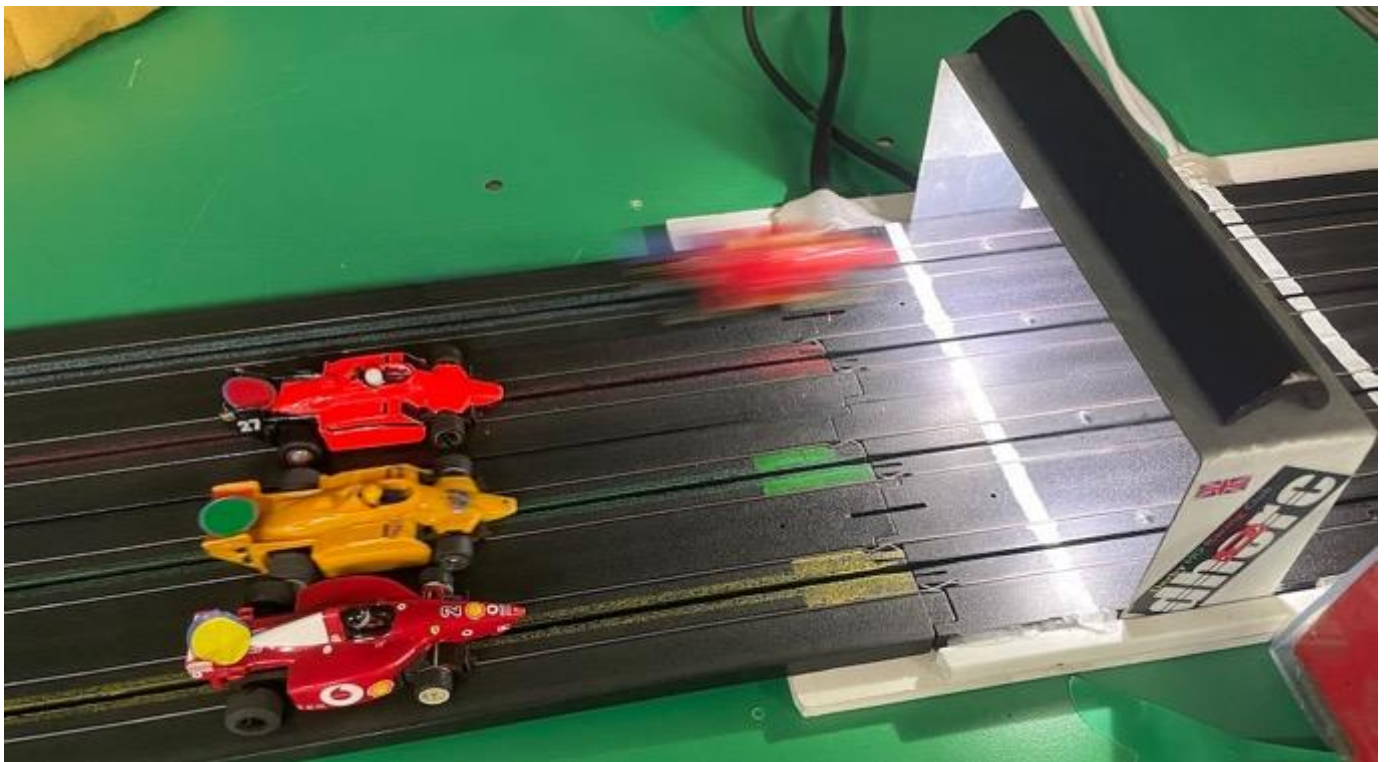

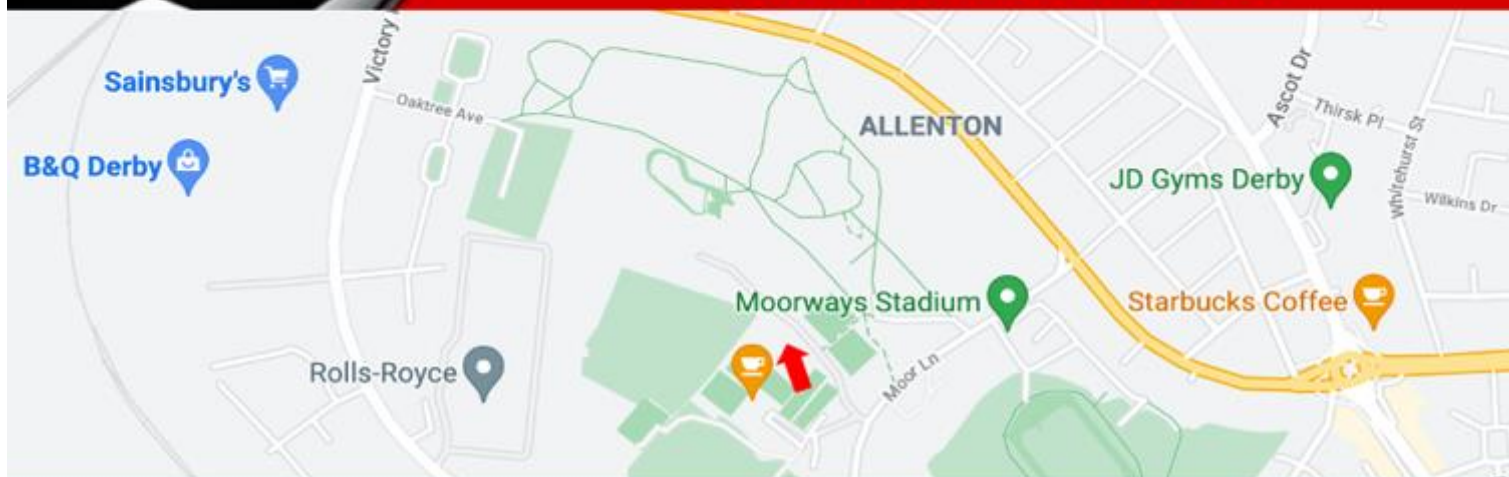
