F1 Finals ADULT REPORT F1 Finals

Chris takes his 1st Adult Win!

'A' Final – **Chris Bowles** made it! He scored his first Adult DHORC Club Night win at his 120th attempt! Since his return to DHORC on 25Feb17 he has taken four 4th place finishes, his first at DHORC 600 on 09Jul19 but he had never quite made it to the top step of the Podium until now. To quote Chris, "I just avoided the carnage all around me". And avoid it he did. As others were drawn in, he kept his head together winning by exactly a lap over, new to the Podium and earlier Junior winner, **JJ Hughes-Dowd** who had to win both the 'C' and 'B' Finals to have a shot at the 'A'. JJ set a whole suit of PB's in the F1 Club Night. Qualifying 7th beat his 8th on 25Jul23, finishing 2nd trounced his 7th on the same date, while he must be the youngest ever "Adult" at 13 to take a best race lap on a Club Night! Both he and Lee (who has a record 190 of them) completed 24.0 laps. Although not a track record it was also a six place improvement for JJ. To add to all of this his he also broke **Phil Rees'** Donington Park Final points record set on 22Feb22 by 0.5 points leaving it at 5.5 points.

Simon Goodlip, looking to secure his fifth Adult Championship, on one hand shot himself in the arm, while on the other helped a developing young Member to reach his potential, by breathing on JJ's F1. **Lee Pateman** pipped his mate Simon to third by 0.2 laps, both within a lap of JJ. While this meant Lee couldn't now win his sixth Championship, it also postponed Simon sipping the champagne, despite his closest rival **Angus Smith** only taking sixth, equalling his worst four-lane track finish of the year.

Simon did take his 7th Pole of the year to draw level with Angus and Lee on the same number, while breaking the absent Adam Turnbull's Qualifying record set on 22Feb22, taking it from 42.9 laps to 46.8. Lee also beat the old record with 46.4. Simon, Lee and Chris also broke Angus' 22Feb22 fastest lap record, Simon taking it down to 6.50 seconds, from 6.99. Lee recorded a 6.66 (the little devil) while Chris took home a 6.96 second lap.

'B' Final – **Phil Rees** was matching JJ here on lap times and it really looked like experience would win through over youth. However, as JJ has showed in both the HO Juniors and Carrera Digital, given the right equipment he can take on the best. And Phil is one of the best with the Tyco 440X2 chassis. JJ eventually eked out a 0.8 lap lead to take him into the 'A' for the first time.

Reigning three time Champion **Angus Smith** should have taken this race with a much quicker car than the rest, but speed seemed to be the name of the game rather than strategy, a few offs soon putting him on the back foot, finishing 0.4 laps behind Phil despite a late recovery drive. **Geoff Peach** followed him home in seventh, a further 0.8 laps back, having taken an excellent fourth in Qualifying.

'C' Final – **Nick Sismey's** incredibly slow and yet well handling F1 took him to 8th on the grid, keeping that slot (pun intended) at the flag by the end of the 'C'. Lapping over a second slower than JJ he nearly saw his rear lights three time as JJ set the equal most laps of the night here with 24.0. Both **Dan Turnbull** and 'D' Final winner **Stuart Gray's** hares lapped quicker than Nick's tortoise. However, while they were only separated by 0.3 laps Dan was 1.5 laps behind Nick, with Stuart rounding out the top ten.

'D' Final – **Lewis Blacker** added two laps to his best race score in Qualifying but still couldn't quite catch Stuart, who took a well-deserved fourth Final win of the year. **Denis Latham** was so excited before the Evening as he had sorted his car tyres out. That soon came crashing down when he realised he had forgotten his cars. Therefore, still taking an 'E' Final win with a Club Car, was a great result, finishing 2.4 laps behind Lewis in 11th and 2.5 laps ahead of **Dan Hughes-Dowd** who would come into his own in the GC Finals.

'E' Final – **Harry Smith** was Denis' biggest Member challenge here but even he couldn't get to within 4.2 laps of the Final winner. He was however able to old off DHORCingham winner and dad **Steve Smith** by 0.3 laps. **Jeffrey Clifton** ran in his first Club Night at DHORC as a Non-Member and actually took second on the track with 15.7 laps with a Club Car.

Andrew Woodhouse qualified in 9th but wasn't able to compete in the Finals and so therefore added to his Wooden Spoon tally for the year in what was his 20th Club Night. He therefore became the 90th Adult Member to start 20 Club Nights or more. Thanks Andrew.

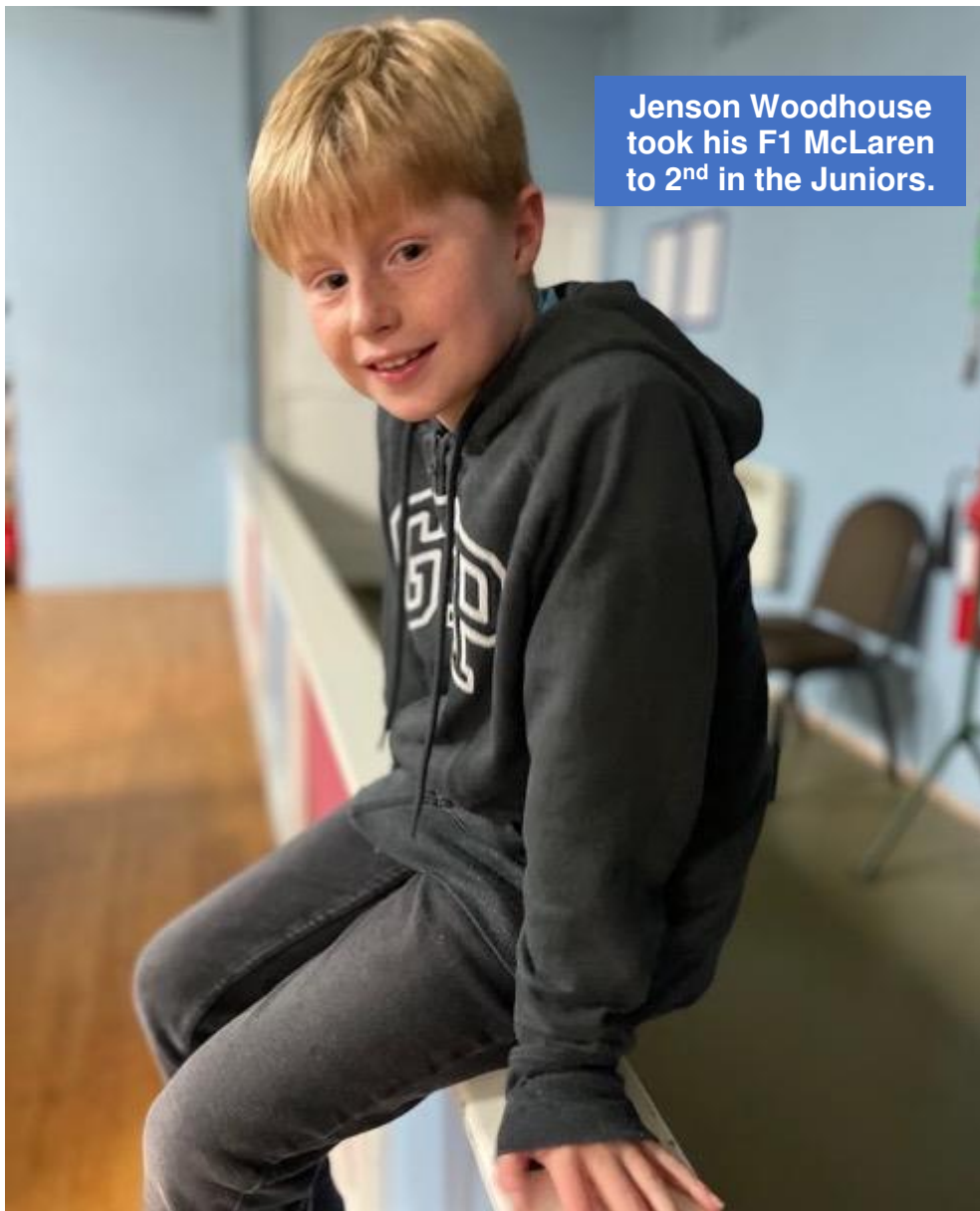
Simon, almost the Champion!

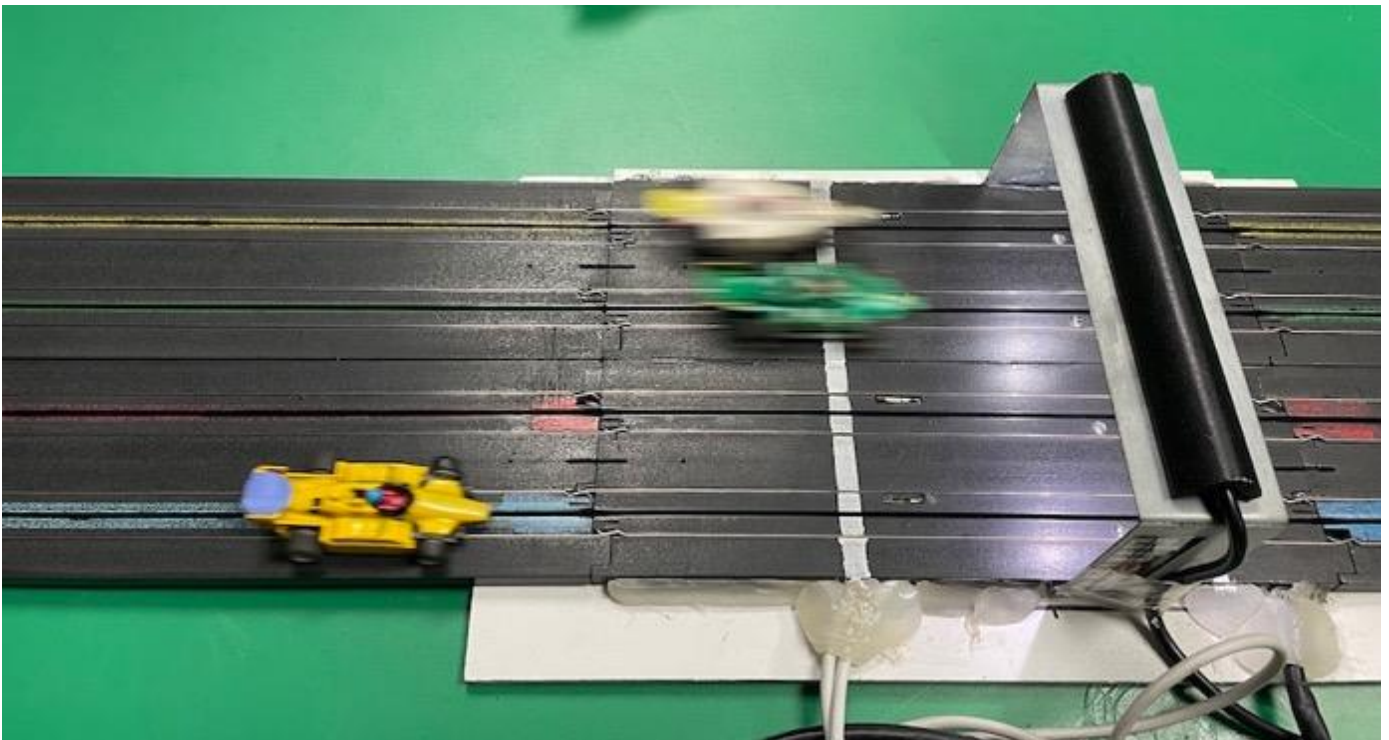

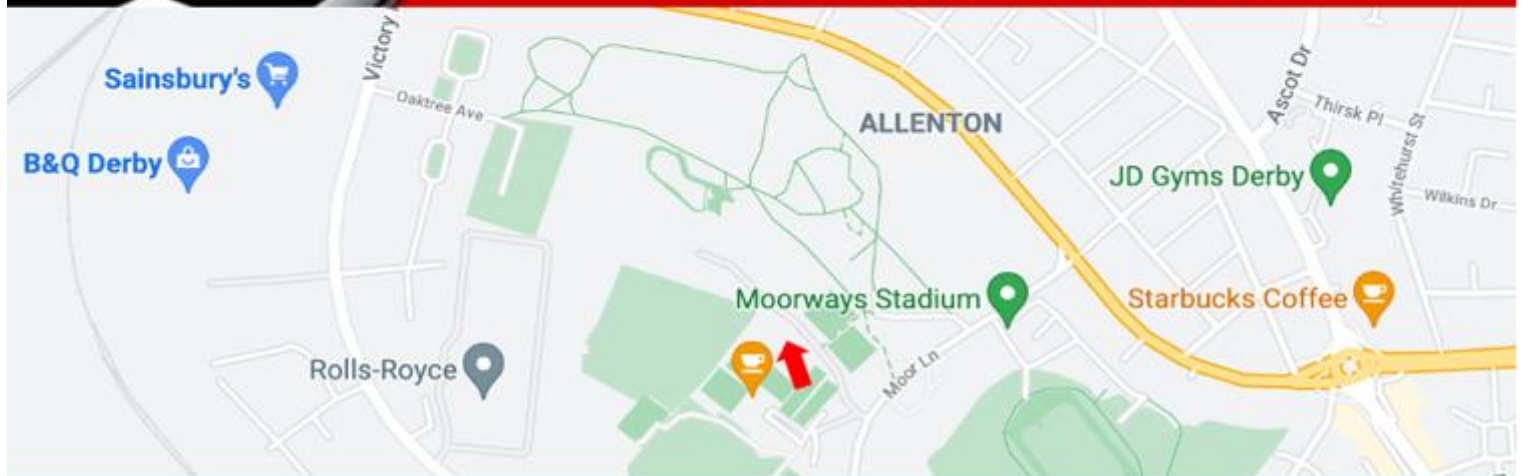
