## Lee takes win, Simon takes 5<sup>th</sup> Championship!

**'A' Final** – Lee Pateman fittingly took the win in the first Club Night of the Evening, F1, as Simon Goodlip matched him on a record 5<sup>th</sup> Adult DHORC Championship. Lee had held the record since 2012 but now we have two five time Champions! While Simon needed but three points to take the Championship, he added none in the F1 Club Night. However after Qualifying that was down to just one point as Angus Smith, while taking Pole with the most race laps couldn't beat Lee on fastest lap so lost two possible points. He simply therefore had to win the race to give him 48 points out of a possible 50 to keep his Championship hopes alive.

Lee qualified just 0.1 laps behind Angus and chose Blue Lane after Angus chose Red. Clearly Blue was the way to go as Lee steadily built up a lead no-one would catch. Having already won the Junior 'A' Final JJ Hughes-Dowd went on the win the Adult 'B' and became Lee's closest challenger from the difficult Yellow Lane. While Lee finished on 28.4 laps the other three finished in the 27s. JJ actually set the most number of laps in the Finals with a 28.8 in the 'B', just 0.1 lap less than Angus' score on Blue in Qualifying. However here, taking three podium finishes for the second time on an Evening, JJ recorded 27.5 laps. That was 0.2 laps more than Simon was able to muster but Simon was happy as he was another 0.2 laps ahead of Angus which meant he was the Champ!

This was Lee's record 122<sup>nd</sup> career win (and back to back wins at Donington Park), with Angus taking his 59<sup>th</sup> Pole and 65<sup>th</sup> race lap win, while Simon took his 63<sup>rd</sup> fastest lap with a new record, the first sub five second lap (4.99) beating his own record of 5.25 seconds set on 01Feb22. These three are so incredibly closely matched, each taking a piece of the action yet again! And JJ isn't far behind!







**Simon Goodlip took a record equalling 5<sup>th</sup> Championship after the F1 Club Night. This was despite having to step in to do Phil Rees' role at Parc Ferme as Phil was off sick!**

**'B' Final** – In his 200<sup>th</sup> Club Night start, across both Junior and Adults (78/122), **Chris Bowles** pushed JJ hard with a quicker lap, recording the third most laps in the Finals, but came short by 0.9 laps. **Nick Sismey**, running a new Geoff Peach (who had to leave early before racing started as he wasn't well) prepared Tyco 440X2 chassis, was able to move a bit further up the grid compared to the incredibly slow car he had been using. Also lapping quicker than JJ (which he hasn't managed for a while) he dropped a further 1.5 laps behind Chris.

**Lewis Blacker** was already celebrating his first Championship win, the DHORC Final Challenge before his car turned a wheel in the 'B'. While his closest rival Phil Rees was unable to attend due to the dreaded lurgy, Simon in third still had a chance before the F1 Finals began. However with Lewis (having had car problems in Qualifying) taking both the 'D' and 'C' Final wins there was no way Simon could accumulate enough Final points to beat him in either F1 or GC. Therefore finishing in seventh 1.3 laps behind Nick mattered little!

**'C' Final** – **Reuben Litherland** kept Lewis in sight throughout the three minutes of the 'C' Final and had there been just one hiccup from the latter Reuben would have pounced. Lewis took the win by 0.8 laps. **Denis Latham** qualified in eighth, two laps down on Reuben in six minutes of racing. Despite only lapping 0.06 seconds slower than Reuben he lost two laps in three minutes this time. But hey, keeping that close to our two time Junior Champion and two time Adult winner after 20 Club Nights compared to Reuben's 199 is no mean feat!

**Barry Johnson** is back! Well at least for a couple of Club Nights! His last race as Member was at DHORC 243 on 25Jan05, his 97<sup>th</sup> Club Night. In his 98<sup>th</sup> he would be running an F1 Club Car and took a very respectful ninth on the grid (exactly halfway) and converted that into a top ten finish to suit! Just 0.5 laps down on Denis he set the second quickest lap time of the Final.

**'D' Final** – **Dan Turnbull** shared Race Control with both Lewis and Simon. He even set up the computer without the need to call Phil, very impressive. Here however both he and Lewis were duelling out for 'D' supremacy. Dan had out qualified Lewis by four laps so looked good for the win with first Lane choice. He went for Red with Lewis on Green. Lewis' had found an issue with his car, also prepared by Geoff, that the crown wheel and pinion hadn't been meshing properly in Qualifying. That sorted he was able to challenge Dan and edged a 1.2 lap lead at the flag.

**Harry Smith** lapped quicker than Dan but couldn't match these two taking 12<sup>th</sup> beating an ever improving **Dan Hughes-Dowd** who came up to the 'D' fight after battling his way through the 'E'.

**'E' Final** – **Steve Smith** got closest to Dan in the 'E' and having out qualified him thought he would be moving up to the 'D' however Dan had other ideas. Steve did keep **Stuart Gray** behind him, like in Qualifying, however. Just 0.8 laps separated them in the race to the grid however Green lane didn't seem to gel with Stuart's car in the Final. He did beat his lap score set early in Qualifying on that Lane however!

**'Early F' Final** – **Andrew Woodhouse** out qualified **Alan Stevenson** by 2.3 laps and it looked like it would be a battle of all battles in the Final. However Alan took it 23.4 laps to 19.5! Our 2023 Wooden Spoon Championship winner added another spoon to his collection.

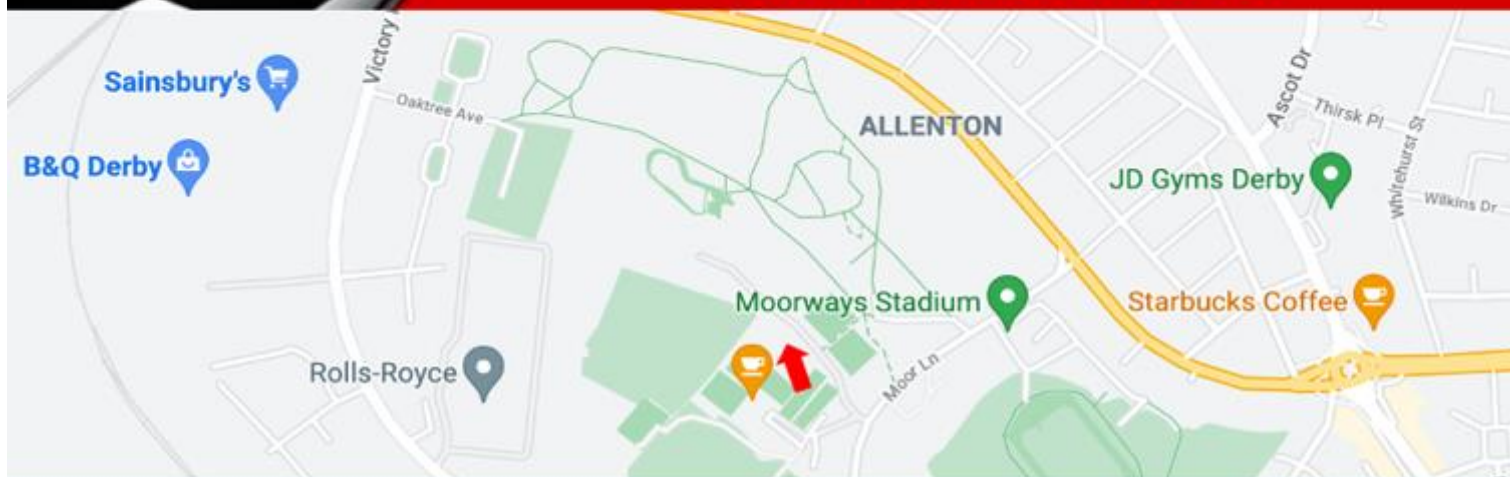
