We are back at the British Touring Car Championship at Donington Park! (Page 7). This is simply amazing as we haven't been able to run our 8-lane Gazebo track there since April 2022. Our first major event at a UK racing track was when we took our Rockingham track to the BTCC event at Rockingham Motor Speedway near Corby over the weekend of 24/25Apr10. From then on we did every BTCC event at Rockingham until it sadly closed at the end of 2018.

Based on photos from our 2010 Rockingham event we also managed to negotiate running a track at the BTCC events at Donington Parks from 2010 through to 2018 in the Paddock Suite in the middle of the paddock. MSV then took over running Donington Park and converted the Paddock Suite into a restaurant Garage 39. Therefore the only way we could continue to run a track there was to invest in a Gazebo where we ran tracks through to April 2022. After that event politics came into play re BTCC events but we have slowly and carefully worked alongside MSV and finally got ourselves back. We are very hopeful to be at both BTCC events in 2026 thanks to support from Andrew and Jarrod at MSV.

It's great to be running a new version of an old favourite, the Jacarepagua circuit, at the end of the year (Page 5) and it is so exciting that we may have a cheaper and local alternative chassis, the Bulldog SRT, to replace the trusty, but now getting expensive Viper we run in GC (Page 15).

Congratulations to **Simon Goodlip** for taking the Adult win, **Gordon Reynolds** the Masters, **James Wardle** the Early Parents and **JJ Hughes-Dowd** the Juniors. **Nick Sismey**

5. *Bulldog SRT may be the new GC chassis*

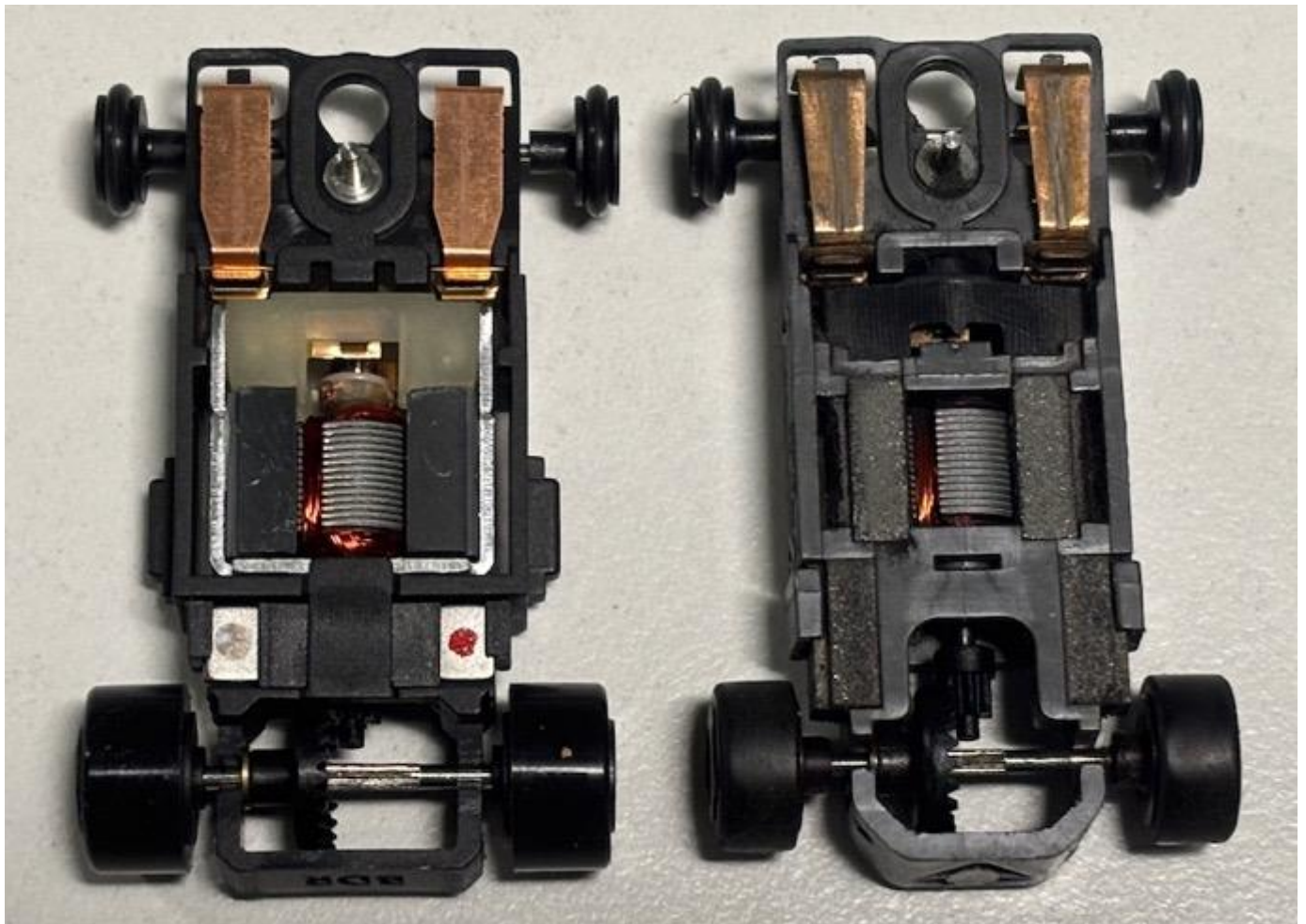
During the Test Night all 24 racers tried out DHORC Member **Barry Johnson's** Bulldog SRT chassis on the left from slotcarsdirect based in Kilburn, just north of Derby.

We currently run the Viper chassis on the right from Lehi, Utah in the USA. The Viper is an incredible chassis taking the original Tomy SGP chassis to a new level. We also ran the BRST chassis from Seattle, Washington in the USA, which was also a great chassis.

Everyone bar one racer beat their Viper lap time on our Test Track with the Bulldog SRT, and even he was only 0.2 seconds quicker with the Viper.

The proposal at the AGM in November is to allow the Bulldog SRT to run alongside the Viper next year and the switch to the SRT full time in 2027.

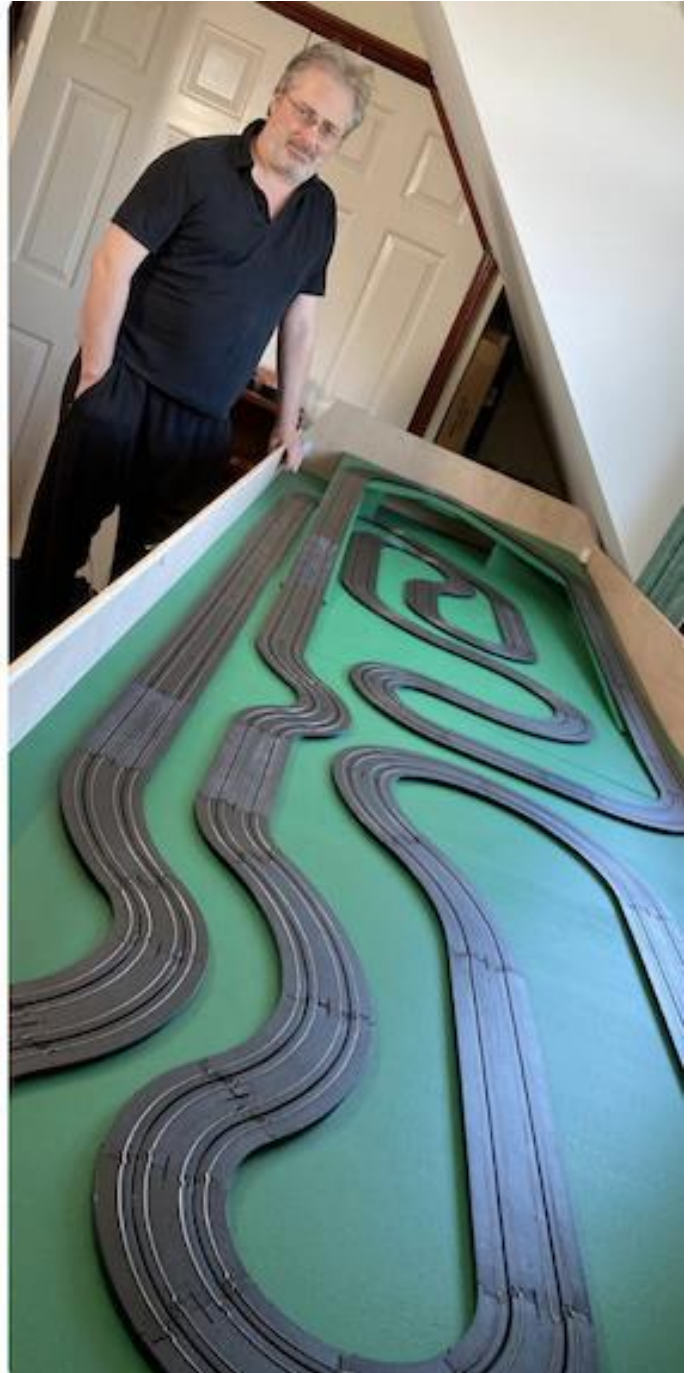
At current prices the SRT is less than half the price of the Viper, which will also help Member's pockets.

Simon wins by a whisker!

'A' Final – Reminiscent of the Giles Villeneuve win at Jarama in his Ferrari in 1981, holding off four other cars for 60 laps, **Simon Goodlip** did the same to record breaking Pole sitter **Reuben Litherland** for 3-minutes to win the first Club Night of the evening by just a tenth of a lap! Reuben had broken the absent Phil Rees' Pole record of 44.2 laps set on 24Sep24 leaving it at 44.4 laps. This was his third career Pole and first since 23Jul24 at the dhorcingham oval. It was also his second track record. Simon made it three wins in a row at Jarama as he notched up his 103rd career win and 4th of the year. To add to that he took his 77th (4th) fastest lap and 87th (4th) most race laps. Only Reuben prevented Simon taking home maximum points by taking three off him during Qualifying.

Chris Bowles took the most Final points in F1 with 3.0 after winning the 'B' and finishing 2.1 laps behind Reuben in third, with second on the grid and Championship leader **Angus Smith** dropping out 30 seconds from the end with car handling problems in fourth.

'B' Final – Despite lapping nearly 1.5 second slower than **Lee Pateman**, **Nick Sismey** somehow managed to take second in the 'B' behind Chris, some 1.2 laps in arrears. While his car was painfully slow on the straights it was the best handling through the corners giving him a 1.3 advantage over Lee who had out qualified Nick by just a tenth.

Lewis Blacker keeps adding to his DHORC Challenge point lead by winning the 'C' Final and then taking another half point for finishing at the back of the 'B', six tenths behind Lee.

'C' Final – **Stuart Gray** seems to be having a renaissance in both Carrera Digital and HO at present. He was only another tenth behind Nick in Qualifying. Unfortunately that dropped him a Final to the front of the 'C' grid, where despite first lane choice he couldn't hold onto Lewis' shirt tails, finishing eighth, some 0.6 laps back, his second best finish of the year! **Denis Latham** matched Stuart on lap time to the hundredth but lost 2.3 laps during the 3-minute Final, taking ninth.

Gordon Reynolds qualified down in 15th but thanks to four racers above him on the grid being in the Early Parents' Final and Gordon winning the 'D' Final he would close out the top ten, two laps behind Denis.

'D' Final – **Jim Dudley**, running his freshly painted pink cars, matched his grid slot with his finishing position, 11th, second to 'C' Final destined Gordon, the gap 1.2 laps. **James Wardle** had the biggest jump up the order, from 18th on the grid to finish in 12th just a tenth behind Jim while friend **Nick Jarram** was another half lap back in 13th.

Early Parents' 'E' Final – **Andrew Woodhouse** lost Pole for the early Finals to **Steve Whittaker** by a staggering 6.1 laps however the battle for the win was between Andrew and **Dan Hughes-Dowd** (who also out qualified him). Andrew overturned a 0.7 laps deficit in Qualy to beat Dan by exactly a lap here to take the overall win. However it was **James Crunden** who took home the most Early Parents points for winning the first Final and then taking fourth (17th) in this one. We will probably have to go back to overall points again for this Championship next year as Final Points don't really work here.

Back to Steve, who, with fifth on the grid overall, set a PB, beating his sixth at DHORC 727 at Zandvoort on 29Apr25. However his 6.1 lap lead on the grid turned into a 1.1 lap deficit to Andrew and 0.1 lap deficit to Dan as he finished in 16th.

Early Parents' 'F' Final – **Mike Graham** had beaten James in Qualy by two places but left for home with his fifth Wooden Spoon to take the lead in that Championship, 0.8 laps behind James in 18th.

JJ heads towards back-to-back Championships

'A' Final – JJ Hughes-Dowd already has one hand on his second straight Junior Championship with his 13th win of the year and 47th of his career, taking him to second in the all-time stats. His fourth straight Jarama win, and third consecutive win of 2025 was also his eighth perfect 50 points haul of the year. Despite this he still can't yet be confirmed as this year's Champ. Added to this he also took his third straight Pole, his 47th (16th), taking him to third in the all-time listings together with his third straight fastest lap and most race laps leaving him on 42 (14) and 44 (15) respectively. He also broke his own fastest lap track record of 7.43 seconds reducing it to 7.31.

This was some turn around after losing Pole by 4.4 laps! Jenson Woodhouse had to settle for fourth this time 1.6 laps behind JT.

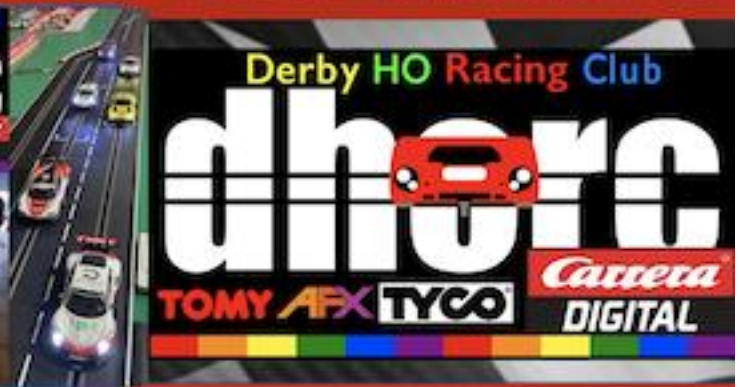

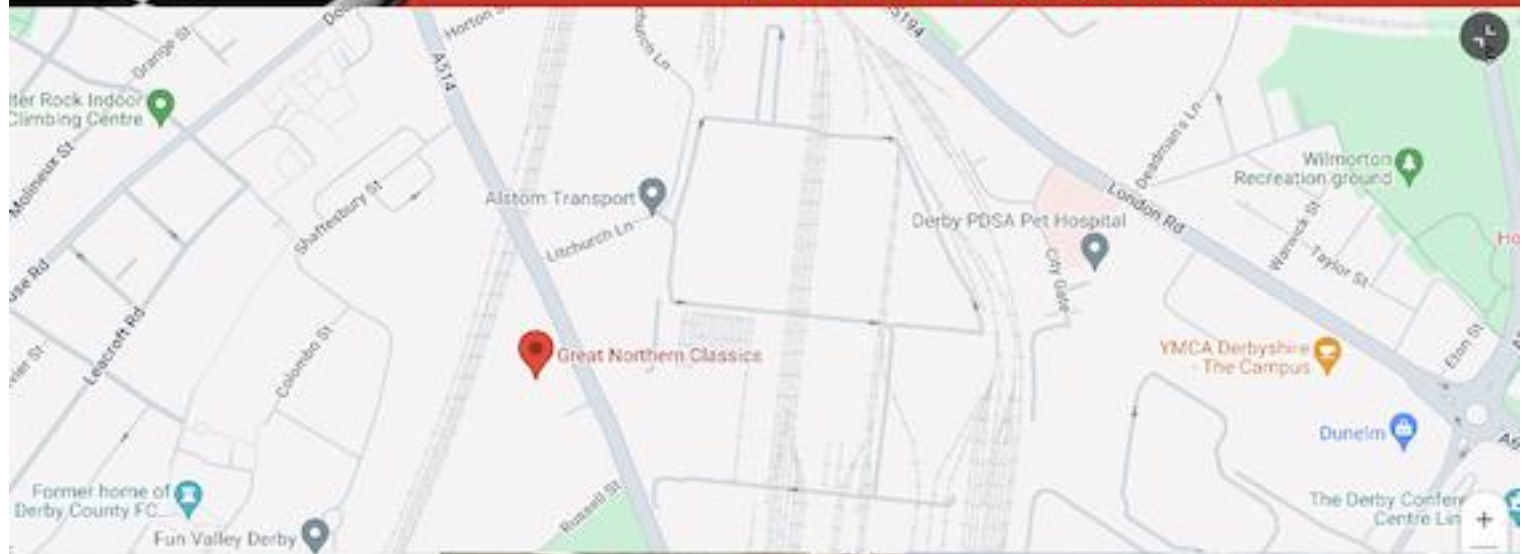
